

## **1. The Wanderer – CI\$100**

Start to explore the world of wine with this light introduction.  
Light to heavy, fruity and earthy, a wide variety of fruit driven wines stimulate and intrigue.

### **Wines included in The Wanderer:**

#### ***Tinazzi Prosecco, Valdobbiadene, Italy NV***

Made from the Glera grape, this is a traditional style of prosecco with a fruit forward palate and a vibrant mousse. This is a fun fresh and fruit driven wine with notes of apple, pear and citrus. With its bright acidity this wine is a perfect match for shellfish, seafood or as an aperitif.

#### ***Domaine de Bel Air, Pouilly Fume, France 2018***

A ripe, vibrant Sauvignon Blanc. Aromatic and generous on the palate with citrus, tropical notes, flint and a subtle salinity, this is a fun fresh drop.

#### ***Domaine Chaberts, Provence, Rose, France, 2018***

This biodynamically farmed, low yield Rose has a concentrated floral nose with delicate red fruits shining through. Lilacs and wild strawberries give a fresh aroma which translates to an elegant palate. Fresh, dry, with a bright approachable acidity.

#### ***The Foreign Affair, Conspiracy, Niagara Peninsula, Canada 2010***

Based on Cabernet Franc with aromas of dark berries, fresh raspberry, cola, eucalyptus, anise and hints of cigar tobacco. Fruit following through to the palate, with balanced acidity, smooth tannins and a long finish.

#### ***Xavier Vignon, Arcane XV, Le Diable, Vallee du Rhone, France 2015***

Blueberries, blackberries, peppery herbs and cooking spices all come together on nose and palate from this layered, full-bodied wine that is focused. This wine has well integrated acidity, structure and a long finish.
