

3. The Aficionado – CI\$150

Tasty top tier wines from Europe and from 2 of the most famous wine making regions. Structure, acid, tannin and body intertwine and titillate your taste buds.

Wines included in The Aficionado:

Monmarthe, Privilege, Premier Cru, Brut Rose, NV

Made up of 40% Pinot noir, 40% Meunier and 20% Chardonnay, you can smell some notes of hawthorn and white peach, you can taste a wine slightly honeyed with aromas of cherry plums. This wine has a delicate mousse and creamy, weighted mouth feel.

Jean Luc Joillot, Le Trezin, Puligny Montrachet, France, 2016

With a powerful but complex nose, this wine is filled with aromas of dried fruit, yellow flowers baking spaces and toast. This wine is full bodied with balanced acidity with a long finish. It develops beautifully in the glass.

Chateau la Rouviere, Bandol, France 2018

This wine is made from 100% organically and biodynamically hand-picked grapes from the oldest vines on the estate. This gives makes focused and concentrated flavour and nose, yet refreshing and dry.

Roger Sabon, Prestige, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France 2015

This wine has fresh aromas of dark toasted baking spices, licorice and dark plum blackberries and dark cherries on the nose. Following through to the palate, with a robust mouthfeel, silky tannins and a long finish.

Mastrojanni, Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 2013

On the nose there are notes of plum and ripe black and red berries, hints of baking spice and tobacco with a fresh, earthy minerality. The palate offers a rich and thick texture, supported by a good acidity and elegant and dense tannins, which extend in a long finish.
