

4. The Connoisseur – CI\$200

Grand Cru's to Super Tuscans, Botrytis affected Rieslings to Cru level Burgundy, enjoy these wines, classic examples from world class regions. These wines are prime examples of wine at its peak.

Wines included in The Connoisseur:

Krug, Grand Cuvee, Champagne NV

A beautifully rich champagne, with notes of toasted bread, hazelnut, nougat, barley sugar and jellied fruits. With hints of apples still on the tree, flowers in bloom, ripe and dried fruit, almonds, marzipan, gingerbread, sweet spices and brioche and honey.

Pegasus Bay, Bel Canto, Dry Riesling, Waipara, Canterbury, New Zealand 2014

A dry, crisp wine with nectarine, peach, apricot, and citrus fruits, particularly mandarin, orange, and lime. floral element gives hints of honeysuckle and orange blossom. On the palate spicy with lingering impressions of mango and crushed ginger.

Vasse Felix, Heytesbury, Chardonnay, Margaret River, Australia 2016

Stone fruit and citrus dominant on the nose, such as white peaches and nectarines, with grapefruit and lemon. Notes of hazelnuts and sweet baking spices add to the complexity of this wine. With a flinty minerality, and a bright acidity, this wine is a Margaret River classic.

Henri Boillot, Caillerets, Volnay, 1er Cru, Burgundy, France 2014

Fresh and focused with fine tannins and spice. Cherries, red plums and ripe red and dark berries integrate with the spice notes and leave a long supple finish. A delicate but complex wine with balanced acidity.

Orma, Tuscany, Italy 2014

Notes of red and black fruit are supported by sweet spice, cocoa, dry earth, Mediterranean herbs and tobacco. On the Palate, Orma is elegant and dense with the nose following through to the palate. Orma has a velvety texture, bright acidity and a long finish.
