#### **Docent**

Interact with people from around the world, handle museum artifacts, and play a key role in educating and promoting stewardship in our visitors! Staff the exhibits, lead tours, or run the Touch Table. For: lifelong learners and people who love people. No prior experience needed. Training in museum content and public speaking provided. Those with basic knowledge of the Salish Sea preferred.

#### Soundwatch Volunteer

Protect killer whales and other marine mammals by educating boaters about protective guidelines and behavior. For: the resilient and observant. No prior experience needed; boating experience a plus. Must be 16 or older. Training provided. Needed May-Oct. Minimum 3 full days a summer asked.

#### **Stranding Network Volunteer**

Investigate live and dead stranded marine mammals in the field, collect data, and participate in harassment mitigation, public education, and necropsies. For: the resilient and science lovers. No prior experience needed; boating and animal handling experience a plus. Includes scheduled training sessions. Majority Jun-Sept but needed all year. 3+ month commitment preferred. Mailing list available for those interested.

#### Sightings Network Volunteer

Enter sightings of marine mammals throughout the Salish Sea to help us keep track of long-term distribution and habitat trends. For: the detail-oriented and computer literate. No prior experience needed; experience with Microsoft Access a plus.

#### **Orca Adoption Volunteer**

Compile and send informational packets about resident orcas to raise funds for ongoing research. For: the organized and computer literate. No prior experience needed.

## **Marine Naturalist Training Volunteer**

Assist with Marine Naturalist training, including lectures, field trips, and hands-on learning. For: the organized and friendly. Must have completed the course.

### **Pod Nod Sleepovers Volunteer**

See the museum after hours and supervise education sleepovers for children; includes art and science projects and a flashlight tour of the exhibits. For: the patient and people who love kids. No prior experience necessary. Needed summer only.

#### **Lime Kiln Point State Park Volunteer**

Introduce people to the best land-based whale watching in the world and educate about the hydrophones and research conducted at the Park. For: lifelong learners and people who love people. No prior experience needed. Training in exhibit content and public speaking provided.

#### **Museum Library and Collections Volunteer**

Participate in the ongoing effort to catalog and digitize the museum's library and collection. *For: the computer literate and detail-oriented. No prior experience needed.*
