
## KEEP IT SIMPLE

CREATE A COLLECTION INSPIRED BY THE HARMONIOUS INTERPLAY OF NATURE, INCORPORATING ELEMENTS SUCH AS LANDSCAPES, FLORA, AND FAUNA. EXPLORE THE DIVERSE COLORS, TEXTURES, AND PATTERNS FOUND IN THE NATURAL WORLD.



#### INSPIRATIONAL PORTRAITS

SHOWCASE THE STRENGTH, RESILIENCE, AND UNIQUE STORIES OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE OVERCOME ADVERSITY. THROUGH PORTRAITURE, BRING ATTENTION TO THE TRIUMPH OF THE HUMAN SPIRIT AND THE POWER OF RESILIENCE IN THE FACE OF CHALLENGES. THESE CAN BE FAMOUS PEOPLE OR LOCAL HEROES.



#### **CULTURAL ROOTS**

RESEARCH AND IMMERSE YOURSELF IN THE TRADITIONS, CUSTOMS, AND SYMBOLISM OF YOUR ANCESTORS. CREATE ARTWORKS THAT PAY HOMAGE TO YOUR CULTURAL BACKGROUND, INCORPORATING ELEMENTS SUCH AS TRADITIONAL ATTIRE, SIGNIFICANT SYMBOLS, AND HISTORICAL REFERENCES.



#### WANDERLUST

CREATE AN ART SERIES THAT CAPTURES THE ESSENCE OF DIFFERENT DESTINATIONS, CULTURES, AND EXPERIENCES FROM YOUR TRAVELS. EACH ARTWORK CAN REPRESENT A SPECIFIC LOCATION OR A COLLECTION OF MOMENTS THAT EMBODY THE SPIRIT OF YOUR JOURNEYS.
