## Components

Number of Shelves	2	3	4
Corner Upright	4 @ 61cm	4@91cm	4@122cm
Horizontal "A" 981mm	4	6	8
Horizontal "B" 399mm	4	6	8
Square Nuts & Bolts	32	48	64
Seed Trays	8	12	16


- 1. Please check the components.
- 2. Decide at what level you wish to set the shelves. Mark \* the inside of each upright with these levels so that you know where to attach the horizontals.
- 3. Take two uprights and attach the horizontals A (2, 3 or 4 depending on the height of the rack) and slide sufficient bolts down each channel (2 per shelf - dia. 1); line up the horizontals with the marks you have made; slide the bolts to match up with the holes in the horizontals (dia. 2); locate the horizontals over the bolt stems and fasten them with the nuts; square up and tighten. This will give you one side section - repeat to make the other.
- 4. Join the two side sections with the horizontals B. Step one, position the slot in bar B over the flat of A. Step two; slide B onto the bolt stems (dia. 3).
- 5. Check that the trays are a snug fit before finally tightening up.

## **Please Note.**

If your rack has been supplied with watertight gravel trays an angle support has been included for each tray. This sits across the frame before the tray is positioned.


