


PREPARATION

We strongly advise that you anchor your arch down with either fixtures shown below to enhance stability. You will need to purchase these separately. Apply each fixture to each leg before fully constructing your arch. 130mm of your post will be supported within the fixture.



FOR PATIO/DECKING (HARD SURFACES)

Easy-Fit Fencebase - 65mm (FBEF65)



FOR GRASS/SOIL (SOFT SURFACES)

Easy-Fit Fencefast (FEF6575)

Ensure that the spike can be inserted into the ground by 750mm.

Assembly requires 2+ adults.






Lay out the Posts on the floor as shown above. Space the posts to your desired width.




Position and secure the Flat Top Rafter to the Posts. Ensure it is flush to the top of the Posts when positioning as shown above.




Position and secure the Braces to the corners of the arch. Ensure the Brace is flush on to the Flat Top Rafter as shown above.



Position and secure 2 x Notched Rafters to the Flat Top Rafter. Position your Notched Rafters to your desired spacing.



Position and secure 1 x Notched Rafter in the centre of the Flat Top Rafter, as shown above.



Position and secure the remaining Notched Rafters to the Flat Top Rafter.


