

How to use the Tropf Blumat pressure reducer Q17 (05)

Ready for immediate connection, the unit comes complete with a filter and the output pressure set to 1 bar. The unit has threaded inlet designed to fit 3/4" threaded taps and a barbed outlet to accept 1/4" (8mm) tube.

A system consisting of a maximum 500 drippers and 120m (60m in 2 legs) of tube can be run off one pressure reducer.

It is unimportant at what angle the reducer lies.

IMPORTANT

To prevent frost damages ensure you remove the pressure reducer from the tap prior to first frosts.

N.B. Quite a large amount of water can be expected from the unit when checking output prior to a system being connected. However, it should be possible to close the flow by sealing the outlet with a finger, this is due to the back pressure being created which is required by the unit to function.

HEIGHT DIFFERENTIALS

Subjects can be mounted a maximum of 4m above the pressure reducer, or a maximum of 3m below.
