



## **Nantucket Throw Pattern**

28" x 40" (70 cm x 100 cm)

**LEVEL: BEGINNER**

Time to Complete: **2-3 hours**

### **MATERIALS**

**Yarn: 1 BIG LOOP YARN (40 oz 1134 g, 125 yards 115 m) 100% Merino, Dry Clean**

**Knitting Needles: US 50 25 mm straight or circular, at least 19" long**

### **PATTERN**

**FOR BEST RESULTS KNIT LOOSELY**

**Gauge: 10 stitches/15 inches 38 cm**

**Pull yarn out from the middle**

**Cast on 18 stitches**

**Row 1** K2, \*P2, K2; rep from \* to end (repeat for all odd numbered rows)

**Row 2** P2, \*K2, P2; rep from \* to end (repeat for all even numbered rows)

**Cast off**

**Tip:** One skein will make 1120 square inches / 7171 square cm. To make a different size, calculate the area of finished garment (width times length in inches) and divide that number by 1120 if measuring in inches or 7171 if measuring in cm. This will give you the number of skeins required to make your desired size

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
