











# The Warley Stock Box

<b>How to Construct the Inserts of the Model Box</b>	
	<p><b>Step 1</b> Separate the three insert sections from the large sheet received.</p>
	<p><b>Step 2</b> Remove the semi circular pieces from the shelf divider and put to one side.  Discard the semi circular piece.</p>
	<p><b>Step 3</b> Remove the pieces from the internal shelf dividers and discard or the small cutouts.  Put each section to one side.</p>
	<p><b>Step 4</b> Remove the cut out pieces for the tray and discard.</p>
	<p><b>Step 5</b> With the brown side face up, fold over at the crease each section at where the cut outs have been removed.  You will see two creases that will need to be folded over. Repeat across the whole sheet.</p>
	<p><b>Step 6</b> With the white side face up, fold over the remaining creases with not cut outs, including the two end pieces.</p>
	<p><b>Step 7</b> Lay the tray across the outer box.  Push the tray into the outer box and ensure the two end flaps side up along the side of the box so that the parts of the sheet with cut outs are standing up.</p>
	<p><b>Step 8</b> Take each tray divider section and fold across the two creases so the white side is face up.</p>
