Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Tastegreece Food Trading Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **Shop 7**, **25 Anzac Road**, **Browns Bay**, **Auckland 0630**, and known as **Little Greece**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

The conditions of the licence are as follows:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold on or delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- b) Alcohol may be sold on the premises only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 6.00pm Sunday 8.30am to 3.00pm

- c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- d) Only alcohol produced in Greece is to be displayed and offered for sale and supply.
- e) Only the area delineated on the plan date stamped 20 August 2019 is a permitted area for the display and promotion and advertisement of alcohol. A copy of the plan is to be displayed either alongside the licence or be available for viewing at a point of sale.
- f) The whole of the premises is **Undesignated**.
- g) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either-
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

This licence expires at the close of 20 September 2020 unless renewed.
