




### STYLE 2-3 (ONE WIDE SIDE SWAG BACKDROP)



Backdrop size: 8'Wx8'H

# STYLE 2-3 (ONE WIDE SIDE SWAG BACKDROP)

#### Step 4



#### Preparing 1st layer

Take an adjustable cross bar and extend it to 8' width. (check our hardware instructions if you need help in operating cross bar)

Slide 4 to 6 drape panels depending on the type on to the cross bar. Here we are using 6 Champagne lycra drape panels.

#### Step 5



### Hanging 1st layer cross bar

Hang the crossbar on the additional crossbar hanger attached to the uprights. It is recommended to take the help of another person here to hold the other end of the cross bar.

# Step 6



### Distributing Drapes on 1st layer crossbar

Distribute all drape panels evenly on entire width of the cross bar.

### Step 7



## Preparing 2<sup>nd</sup> layer

- . Take another adjustable cross bar and extend it to the same width as the first one.
- ii. Slide even number of drape panels onto the cross bar. Here we are using  $4-12^{\prime}$  long ivory sheer voile drapes




### Hang the 2<sup>nd</sup> crossbar in the upright slots

Hang the second cross bar on upright slots.

It is recommended to take the help of another person here to hold the other end of the crossbar.

#### Step 9



### Distributing Drape panels on 2<sup>nd</sup> layer cross bar

- Distribute 4 Ivory sheer voile drape panels evenly on 8' width
- ii. Lock the drape at one end of the crossbar, and slide the drape on upright on other end of the crossbar.

#### Step 10




#### Raising the backdrop

Raise the backdrop to the desired height by raising the upright in small sections.

\*Do not raise over 12'

(check our hardware instructions if you need help in operating upright)

#### Step 11







#### Aligning and making swags

- i. Decide the tying point on the upright far from locked end of the drape.
- ii. Gather first two drape panels and tie it loosely to the tying point with Velcro strap.
- iii. Now gather 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> drape to the same tying point.
- iv. Make sure each drape panels are aligned with each other without much overlapping and gaps in between.

### **Finishing touches**

- Align and arrange first layer drapes nicely. Extra length at the bottom can be folded back of the backdrop.
- ii. Arrange 2<sup>nd</sup> layer drape under tying point as shown.
- iii. Take one additional drape, tie one end as shown and hang that on the exposed upright.

### Optional:

Hang the chandelier in the middle or add flower bouquet on the tying points or add any other accessories you may like.
