







## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

### STYLE 3-1 (THREE LAYER BACKDROP)







Backdrop size: 8'Wx8'H

<p>Step 1</p>		<p><b>Base plates placement</b> Place the base plates in the desired location at the width of the backdrop. You can use 8' crossbar to measure the width from pin to pin. *If you are making the backdrop on hardwood, laminate or other floor which may get damaged, we suggest using a plate size cardboard underneath the plates.</p>
<p>Step 2</p>		<p><b>Erecting uprights</b> Check the base plate pin, it should not be wobbly. If needed, turn the pin in the clockwise direction to tighten. Now slide the upright lower section on to the pin.</p>
<p>Step 3</p>		<p><b>Additional Crossbar hanger</b> Attach an "9" additional crossbar hanger "to the back slot of each upright.</p>
<p>Step 4</p>		<p><b>Preparing 1<sup>st</sup> layer</b> Take an adjustable cross bar and extend it to 8' width. (<a href="#">check our hardware instructions if you need help in operating cross bar</a>) Slide 4 to 6 drape panels depending on the type on to the cross bar. Here we are using 6 Champagne lycra drape panels.</p>



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



### STYLE 3-1 (THREE LAYER BACKDROP)

Step 5		<b>Hanging 1<sup>st</sup> layer cross bar</b> Hang the crossbar on the additional crossbar hanger attached to the uprights. It is recommended to take the help of another person here to hold the other end of the cross bar.
Step 6		<b>Distributing Drapes on 1<sup>st</sup> layer crossbar</b> Distribute all drape panels evenly on entire width of the cross bar.
Step 7		<b>Preparing 2<sup>nd</sup> layer</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>i. Take another adjustable cross bar and extend it to the same width as the first one.</li><li>ii. Slide required number of drape panels onto the cross bar. Here we are using 2 – 12' long ivory Lycra and one gold sequin drape.</li></ul>
Step 8		<b>Hanging 2<sup>nd</sup> crossbar</b> Hang the second cross bar on the second set of slots on additional crossbar hanger. It is recommended to take the help of another person here to hold the other end of the crossbar.



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### STYLE 3-1 (THREE LAYER BACKDROP)

<p>Step 9</p>		<p><b>Distributing Drape panels on 2<sup>nd</sup> layer crossbar</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Distribute 3 drapes evenly on the middle 4' section of the crossbar and lock both ends with the Velcro straps provided.</li><li>Lock both ends of each drape panel with the Velcro strap provided</li></ol>
<p>Step 10</p>		<p><b>Preparing and hanging 3<sup>rd</sup> layer</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Take another adjustable crossbar and extend it to the same width as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> layer crossbar.</li><li>Slide required number of drape panels onto the crossbar. Here we are using 4 – 12' long ivory sheer voile drapes.</li><li>Hang the 3<sup>rd</sup> layer crossbar on the upright slots</li></ol>
<p>Step 11</p>		<p><b>Distributing Drape panels on 3<sup>rd</sup> layer crossbar</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Distribute 4 Ivory sheer voile drape panels evenly on 8' width.</li><li>Lock the edges of 2<sup>nd</sup> &amp; 3<sup>rd</sup> drape panel in the middle of the crossbar.</li><li>At both ends of the crossbars, slide the pocket of drape panel on to the uprights to cover them.</li></ol>
<p>Step 12</p>		<p><b>Raising the backdrop</b></p> <p>Raise the backdrop to the desired height by raising the upright in small sections.</p> <p><i>*Do not raise over 12'</i></p> <p><a href="#">(check our hardware instructions if you need help in operating upright)</a></p>

### STYLE 3-1 (THREE LAYER BACKDROP)

#### Aligning and making swags

- i. Decide the tying point on the uprights.
- ii. Gather the outer drape panel to the tying point on the upright, then continue to gather the next drape to this point until all drapes (in our case 2) from the middle point are gathered. Make sure to align the drapes so they do not overlap or create a gap between them.
- iii. Tie gathered drape panels loosely to the upright at the tying point.
- iv. Repeat step i to iii on other upright
- v. Gather all three drapes of 2<sup>nd</sup> layer in the middle of the backdrop width at the same height as tying points on uprights and tie with Velcro strap provided.

#### Finishing touches

- i. Align and arrange 1<sup>st</sup> layer drapes nicely. Extra length at the bottom can be folded back of the backdrop.
- ii. Arrange 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> layer drape under the knots as shown.

#### Optional:

Add flower bouquet or Tassel on the knots.

Add flower crown

Add Chandelier
