For this new boutique hotel in a Hollywood Regency-style former apartment building, blocks from the Dolby Theatre, interior designer Martyn Lawrence-Bullard took inspiration from the stars (like Jean Harlow and Gloria Swanson) who once lived in the hills nearby. "It made for a flight of fantasy. It's classic Hollywood glam meets a 2020 Gucci runway," says Lawrence-Bullard, who's done up the 24 rooms with four-poster Lucite beds, leopard-pattern rugs, voluptuous wallpaper from his own collection for Cole & Son, and gold-leaf ceilings. Olivetta Restaurant London restaurateur Matt Hermer and wife Marissa (Bravo's Ladies of London) have opened their second L.A. eatery, after the Draycott in the Palisades. Olivetta, in WeHo's old Au Fudge space, is a Mediterranean-inspired restaurant that wows with colorful design. Teal surfaces are paired with French mural-inspired wallpaper, plus marble-topped tables and velvet chairs.
