





planning your pond

Things to consider when planning:

- · Will your pond be viewed from indoors?
- Will there be seating nearby?
- Is there potential for expansion or future additions?
- Do you have small children or pets that may be at risk of drowning?
- Will you be adding fish or aquatic plants? What kind?



safety

- Always dig with caution.
- Call 811 or your local utility company before you begin digging to locate buried pipes or power lines on your property.

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2 location



- Consider how the water garden will enhance your landscape and it's visibility from many areas.
- Avoid locations under trees because falling leaves can clog the pump, and decay matter can cause water quality issues.
- Consider power. A GFCI outlet must be located near the pond (no extension cords!)



planning your pond

elevation

- Build your pond at the highest point of your landscape.
- If it is located at the lowest elevation of the yard your pond may flood, washing away fish and plants.
- Rainwater run-off can contain fertilizers or pesticides, which impact water quality and fish health.




4 sunlight

- How much sunlight do you need?
- If you are going to include plants that require moderate to full sunlight, you will need to choose a location with a minimum of 6 hours of direct sunlight.
- Some shade is important to keep water cool, but keep in mind that trees do lose their leaves.

integration

- The size, scale and layout of your pond should complement the other features of your yard, including your landscaping and terrain.
- The Ultimate Pond Kit includes a 7 ft. x 10 ft. liner, allowing for a max pond size of approximately 5 ft. x 8 ft.





the Ultimate Pond Kit checklist

Safety Know what's below. Call 811 before you dig. Visit https://call811.com/ to find your local contact.
Location Consider: landscape enhancement, visibility from multiple areas Avoid: locations directly under trees that drop leaves or needles that clog filters and affect water quality.
Elevation Your pond should not be built on a slope or grade. If it is located at the lowest elevation of the yard, you will have rainwater run-off that can muddy the water, wash away fish and destroy plants.
Sunlight If you are going to include plants that require moderate to full sunlight, choose a location with a minimum of 6 hours of direct sunlight. Some shade is important, but keep in mind that trees do lose their leaves.
Integration The size, scale and layout of your pond should complement the other features of your yard, including your landscaping and terrain.









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
