

Responsibility: It is the rider, or person responsible, obligation to read and understand the conditions for this event as published in this schedule.

Important Information

1. **ESNZ Registration for Graded Classes:** Entries will not be accepted without ESNZ rider and horse registrations current to 13 February 2021.
2. **Annual Dressage Start:** Is required to enter all DNZ Super 5 Leagues, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Island or National Championships, Horse of the Year and international events. All other classes may be entered using a flexi start.
3. **Rules:** Dressage Northland Premier League competitions will be run under the current (2020/21) ESNZ GR's, VR's & ESNZ Rules for Dressage.
4. **Official start time:** The official event start time is 7.00am Saturday 13th February 2021. This is the start time for the period of jurisdiction for all Equestrian Sport New Zealand (ESNZ) General Regulations and ESNZ Dressage rules. Please note Dressage NZ rule 477 prohibited gear is not allowed from the time of arrival at the event.
5. **Official finish time:** The official finish time will be 60 minutes after the completion of the last class or 60 minutes after the completion of all presentations for the event whichever is the latter.
6. **Protests & Complaints:** Must be lodged within 60 minutes of the official finish time of class in writing, including a fee of \$50.00.
7. **Qualifiers:** Premier League Shows are qualifiers for the Horse of the Year.
8. **Dressage NZ Leagues/Series:** Horses/Ponies must have an annual start for Dressage to gain points in any Super 5 League, Zilco Musical Freestyle Series, Prestige Futures Prize, Pony and Young Rider Performance Leagues, or Top 10 League. Riders must register online at Equestrian Entries prior to 1st December 2020 for inclusion in any Top 10 League, Prestige Dressage Futures Prize, Pony and Young Rider Performance Leagues.
9. **Tests:** All tests from DNZ Test book version 2019 Reprint 1 or FEI Website. (New FEI V 2020/21 apply from 1st Jan 2021 for Small and Medium Tour and Grand Prix. (**Int I, Int A, Int B, Int II.**))
10. **Super 5 Tests:** Must be ridden from memory, no caller is permitted.



Event Conditions

1. **Amendments:** The organising committee reserves the right to refuse entries, cancel the event, alter the programme/schedule and/or prize money within the ESNZ and DNZ Rules.
2. **Presentation of Special Awards Prizes and Prize Money:** See DNZ Rule article 485.
 - a. All riders must attend advertised presentations. The organising committee reserves the right to withhold prize monies should a placegetter not attend an advertised prize giving.
 - b. The organising committee reserves the right to substitute prize money with goods of equal value.
 - c. All prize money will be paid at the event or electronically. Prize Money forfeited if not collected prior to end of show.
 - d. Prize Giving: Mounted for Champions & Reserves. Unmounted - Super 5 League and Zilco Musical Freestyles. All other classes collect from reception.

- e. If 6 or less riders in a class, prize money will be paid out as a sweepstake whilst adhering to article Art 465 of Dressage NZ Rules.
3. **Draw:** If required, a revised draw and/or start times for the following day's competition will be available by 6.30 pm each evening on the results board. It is the rider's responsibility to check any new times posted.
 4. All outstanding amounts from any previous Dressage NZ Event must be paid before entries will be confirmed.
 5. **Scratchings:** Must be notified by text/email to the Event Manager/Secretary (before 9pm)
 6. **Stabling Refunds:** Where stabling requests cannot be met, refunds will be made via internet banking after the show.
 7. **Equal Placings:** In the case of equality in any qualifying class, the higher collective marks will determine the higher placing. If the competitors are still equal, then the higher co-efficient marks will determine the placings. If there is still an equality of points, the competitors are given the same placing.
 8. **Riders with more than 2 horses:** Entries are limited to 4 horses, with a maximum of 6 tests per day per rider. The OC will make every effort to ensure that riders have at least 60 minutes between rides. However, if this is not possible owing to the scheduling of classes, maximum time possible between rides will be allocated.
 9. **Hats:** ESNZ approved riding hats must be worn at all times, at all levels, when mounted.
 10. **Non-competing Horses:** All horses and ponies on the grounds after the official start time must be entered at the event unless the OC gives permission otherwise.
 11. **Media:** Dressage Northland Dressage NZ and ESNZ reserve the right to use event photographs, for marketing, publicity, advertising, funding applications as they see fit. Competitors and/or participants will receive no remuneration for this. All images remain the property of Dressage Northland.
 12. Musical Freestyles: **No tapes and no rewriteable CD's**
 13. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
 14. **Liability:**
 - a) Competitors and spectators attending this event do so at their own risk.
 - b) Barge Showgrounds, ESNZ, Dressage NZ or Dressage Northland nor any representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, injury or illness to horse/pony/rider, spectators, land, vehicles or any personal property whether caused by their negligence or breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
 - c) Dressage NZ or Dressage Northland will not be liable for the security of goods/equipment or the loss of, damage to such, stored at the venue, during the event.
 15. **Health & Safety:**
 - a) Dressage NZ and Dressage Northland are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all participants, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.
 - b) Competitors must comply with appropriate Legislation and Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
 - c) Each Competitor and/or exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves at the venue of the Event
 - d) All competitors and associated staff/visitors to the venue must abide by the ESNZ/Dressage NZ Rules, the Dressage Northland and Barge Showgrounds Health & Safety Policies
 - e) Copies of the event Health & Safety policy can be found at the event office.
 - f) Any incident or near miss must be reported to event office and an incident form completed.
 - g) Any hazards identified must be reported to event office.
 - h) Competitors will be responsible for their safety at all times and must observe safe practices and following event rules and officials' instructions at all times, ensuring that others are not put a risk by their actions.
 16. **ESNZ Concussion Policy:**
 - a) This event will be run under the ESNZ Concussion Policy Guidelines.
 - b) Dressage NZ policy requires all riders to report to Medical Officer or Steward following a fall.
 - c) Medical clearance must be obtained before remounting or competing.

Entry Conditions

1. Entries Close 27th January 2021.
2. Entry will not be accepted until payment is made.
3. Enter online at www.equestrianentries.co.nz. Fax, emailed or phone entries will not be accepted.
4. Late Entries & Changes - Please contact Janet Fox for enquiries, Ph 09 4391080, 021 0613649 or gojfox@farmside.co.nz. May be accepted if entries allow or placed on waiting list until draw is posted.
5. Late penalty fee of \$10.00 per class will apply and proof of payment before entry accepted.
6. Direct credit payments must be made by close of entry for entry to be accepted.

8. Draw will be available at www.equestrianentries.co.nz
9. All horses and riders must be registered with ESNZ.

Withdrawals and Refunds

Applications for refund must be submitted in writing stating rider name, ESNZ registrations and horse's name/s to Paula Romer, 0211555286, jonandpaula1908@gmail.com. Final date for refund applications by Friday 19 February 2021.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event before close of entries.

- Competitors that withdraw prior to close of entries are still liable for online entry fees.
- All other fees paid will be refunded.

Conditions of withdrawal from the event after close of entries.

- Stabling and camping fees will be 100% refunded in all cases.
- Online entry fee and late entry fees will not be refunded.
- Competitors unable to provide a vet or doctors certificate will receive no ground fee and entry fees refund.
- If a doctor or vet certificate is provided ground fee and entry fees will be refunded less 20% per horse
- If vet certificate provided, only the horse to which the certificate applies will receive a refund.
- If doctors certificate provided fees for all horses for that rider will be refunded
- Special applications for refunds can be presented to the OC for consideration.

Championship Eligibility Points Levels Unregistered – Grand Prix

1. Combinations are eligible for one level of Championship only.
2. Champion and Reserve sashes will be awarded.
3. There will be a specific class per level for Championship ie. Champions and Reserves.

Special Awards

1. **Hanoverian Society Award:** Two awards presented to levels, Preliminary-Elementary and Medium and above. The award will be presented to the highest-level Hanoverian champion, if no champion then the reserve. If there is neither, the Sash will lapse for that grade this year. Horses must be registered with NZ Hanoverian Society. **Please state at time of entry to be eligible.**

Competition Arena Use & Familiarisation

1. All Competition Arenas are closed at all times except as stated below.
2. These times may be amended please check times in rider notes provided with the draw.
3. Arena familiarisation is not intended to be used as a full schooling session.
4. Riders need to be considerate of other riders wishing to familiarise their horses.
5. Horses may be hand walked or ridden at walking pace around the exterior of the competition arena unless advised otherwise by the Technical Delegate.



Sponsors & Volunteers

Horse Identification, Venue, Stabling, Accommodation Conditions

1. Approved Dressage NZ Horse/Pony identification numbers must be worn at all times when competing.
2. When not competing, it is compulsory that horses/ponies are identified with ID tags that include the name of person responsible and mobile phone number.
3. All yards and stables are to be left properly mucked out. If not a fee of \$50 will be charged.
4. Temporary yarding must comply with ESNZ rules.
5. Stallions must comply with ESNZ Article 133 and must be housed in a stable at all times.
6. Please keep wash down bays clean at all times.
7. Moving horses to unallocated yards or stables is prohibited without permission of the Stable Manager.
8. Please do not dispose of horse manure around base of trees
9. Entry at State Highway 14, Maunu Whangarei. Gate is locked by security by 11.00pm each night.
10. No smoking in any buildings or stable areas.
11. Damage to Barge Showgrounds facilities to be reported to the Event Office.

Dogs

1. Dogs must be kept in the truck park at all times
2. No dogs are allowed in any stable or yarding areas, warm up, competition areas or buildings
3. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
4. The owner of the dog will be responsible for the cost of any damage/harm caused by the dog at the competition.

Camping & Power Sites

1. Parking and camping areas may be defined. Some areas will be restricted to on site camping/parking only.
2. Day competitors must park in designated day parking areas
3. Trucks and Campervans requesting power must have a valid electrical certificate and under no circumstances will allow other vehicles to connect to their vehicle via extension cords.
4. Please be tidy and use bins for all rubbish – Please, no animal waste in bins.

Vehicles & Access

1. All gates will be locked at 11.00pm and re-opened 6am daily. For access outside these times, arrangements will need to be made with stable manager.
2. Speed limit for all vehicles 15 kph.
3. Motorbikes must not be used after 8.30 pm and must be used in accordance with normal road rules.
4. Persons under 16yrs may not use motorbikes.
5. Approved safety helmets must be worn when riding motorbikes at all times.
6. Joy riding on any part of the grounds at any time will not be tolerated



Professional Services

1. Equine Therapists and Treatment
 - a. Any equine therapists or practitioners who are not veterinarian and intend to provide therapeutic treatment to equines in any capacity at this event in a private or commercial basis must notify the Organising Committee of any treatment prior to the event.
 - b. All practitioners must also comply with the Conditions applicable to this event set out in the Schedule of classes.
 - c. Riders who own their equipment (eg Equissage, Cyclossage or similar) are only permitted to treat their own horses with these systems at the event.
 - d. Any practitioner receiving financial or other gain from providing therapies at the event will be required to pay a trade exhibitor fee at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
2. Other Professionals
 - e. Any other professional intending on providing services at this event must obtain prior agreement from the Organising Committee – this excludes professionals Dressage Coaches assisting in the warmup of competitors and grooms that are in part or full time employment of a competitor.




