

Spott'd Handkerchief Workshop - Materials list:

Silk Scarf – I like the 36" x 36" Silk Habotai scarves from G&S dyes because they have hand sewn hems

Something to mark your fabric with, my preferred method is to use an erasable fabric marker (the kind that erases with water because it will come out in the dye bath), but tailor's chalk will work too

Thread – I like to use buttonhole thread keep in mind, the thinner the thread, the thinner the undyed "circle" will be, and the thicker the thread the wider the undyed "circle" will be

Beads – I like to use a size 9/0 or 8/0 bead, but keep in mind the smaller the bead, the smaller the inner dyed "circle" will be and the bigger the bead, the bigger the inner dyed "circle" will be

12/0		2mm
11/0		2.2mm
10/0		2.4mm
9/0		2.6mm
8/0		3mm
7/0		3.5mm
6/0		4mm
