



2-Minute Cleaning Basics

Make this your daily routine and enjoy a "sputter-free" airbrush.

1. Add several drops of cleaner to the cup (1) and hold a cloth or index finger on the needle cap (2) pull back the trigger (3) to create a "back bubble". Spray onto a tissue until cleaner is removed. Repeat if tissue shows makeup remaining.
2. Dry the cup with a cotton swab.
3. Twist off the back end or "handle" of the brush. This exposes the needle.
4. Unscrew, but do not remove, the "needle chucking nut" which holds the needle in place.
5. Gently remove the needle.
6. Pull the needle over a tissue that has a few drops of cleaner on it.
7. Remove the needle cap and use a cotton swab (add 2 drops of cleaner to the swab) to clean any makeup residue off of the nozzle cap. Put the needle cap back on.
8. Gently reinsert the needle (2), tapping the end to make certain it is properly inserted. Tighten the needle chucking nut (1).
9. Replace the handle. Your airbrush is clean.

Additional Tips

Please be safe: keep away from water, this is an electrical appliance, do not operate it in a wet environment or too close to a water source; use on a surface that is level or stable; this is not a toy, please keep away from children, do not use the cosmetics if allergic to iron oxides, (also known as mineral cosmetics); never spray into your eyes, on an open wound, inflamed or irritated skin.
