

MEASURING GUIDE

These pages contain directions to measure correctly.

Two things to remember when measuring:

Measure everything exact.

Fuji Mats will make all allowances.

If anything special is encountered:

- Draw it out.
- Measure everything.
- Take a picture and email it to **Fuji Mats**.

Fuji Mats will do the best to accommodate the situation.




MEASURING WALLS

Step back and make a rough sketch of the wall.


Be sure to include anything that would require a cutout.

(I.e. Electrical outlets, fire alarms, microphone jacks, vents, etc.)



Start by finding the center of the lane.


This can be done by measuring 72" from the edge of the lane to the middle. **Measure out from this point.**






MEASURING CUTOUTS

REMEMBER: Exact measurements.



Put your tape on the center line and measure to the closest point **A**. Then measure out to the farthest point **B**.

Measure from the top of the mopboard (or wherever the bottom of the padding will start) to the closest point **C**. Then measure to the farthest point **D**.




If your cutout is within 3 feet of a corner that will be padded.

Take a **second** set of measurements from the corner.

(we also need the center line measurements for this also)




MEASURING BEAMS/COLUMNS



Specify what beam/column is made of (concrete block or steel).

Measure from center line down the wall to point **E**.



Measure from the top of the mopboard to the same height as the pads on the wall **H**.


Measure from that point to the front of the beam **I**.






MEASURING CORNERS/DOORS

REMEMBER: Exact measurements.



Measure from center line to the corner J.

Measure distance pad will extend back **K**.



Measure height starting at top of mopboard **L**.

Measure width from hinge to edge of door M.

Measure handles and other cutouts **NOPQ**. (Be sure to allow for the handle's swing)

NOTE: Which direction the doors swings.
