If you don't frame in your mats with wood borders or similar, our double sided tape is a great and easy way to keep your mats snugly fit together.

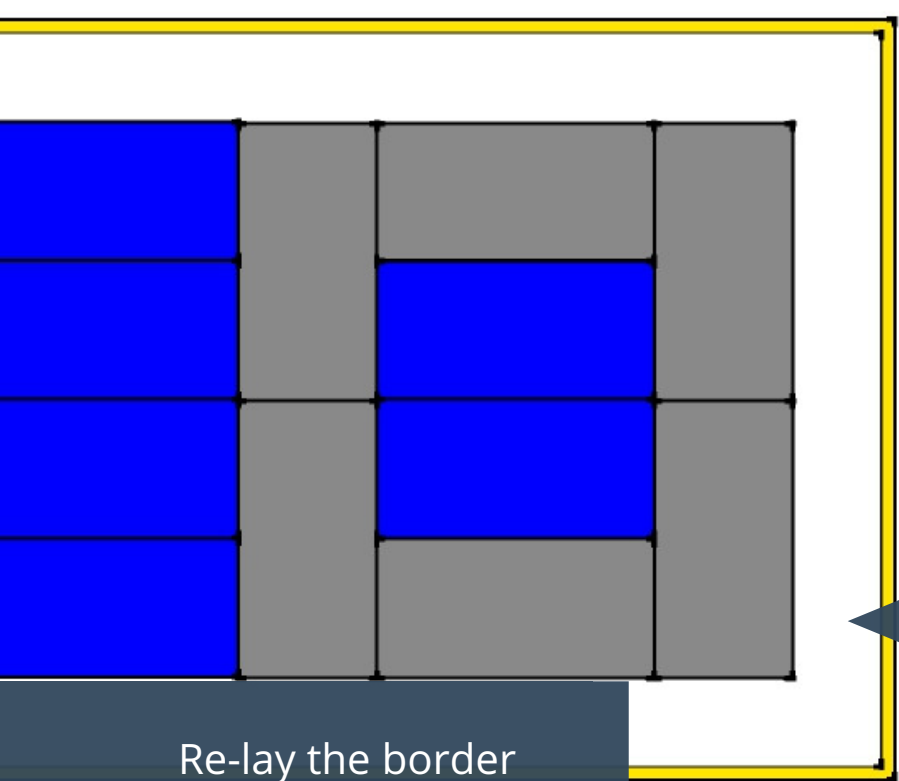
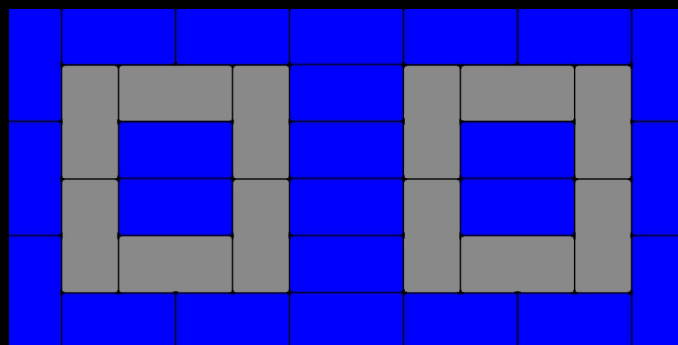

1 Mop & Vacuum your floor. Your subfloor should be **VERY** clean before you lay mats.

Lay mats in the pattern of your choice. Make sure all mats are butted tightly together!

Tip: **Make cuts last**, and put the cut edge against the wall where possible.

Tip: Use **small pieces of tape** to help secure the mats as you work.



3 Re-lay the border mats & start training!!

If you get any gapping, be sure to re-clean your space, and re-apply tape as needed.

Your layout should be super tight!

Lift the border mats and apply Fuji Double Stick Tape **around the perimeter** (www.fujimats.com)

Be sure to keep your layout intact as you move mats

1 or 2 runs around the perimeter of the layout should suffice.
