No. 2 (Rapid Setting 3 - 5 Minutes)

FOR IMPRESSIONS - By Volume - Approx. two (2) parts
Water to three (3) parts Plaster.
(94 ml of Water to 100 g of Powder)

DIRECTIONS FOR MIXING PLASTER No. 2

Mix equal parts of water and material in a clean bowl;
spatulate for 15 seconds. To this thin paint-like wash add
the remaining part of material gradually and spatulate
thoroughly for 15 more seconds with a rapid whipping
stroke. This will ensure equal crystallization throughout the
entire mass. Eliminate air bubbles by rotating bowl or
patting or jarring on sides.

WHEN TO POUR

Continue to spatulate rapidly until thick creamy consistency
is obtained; then pour.

NOTE:

The above proportions are approximate. As these materials
absorb moisture from the air, slight variations in the
proportions may be necessary, depending upon the
atmospheric conditions. It is important to use distilled water
when the natural water of a locality contains a high
percentage of soluble salts, etc.

CAUTION

Inhalation of dry powder can be hazardous to your health.
Use with adequate ventilation to meet TLV requirement. Use
NIOSH-approved respirator for nuisance dust. Gypsums are
subject to deterioration when exposed to atmosphere,
particularly if the humidity is high.

Shelf Life: Refer to package marking. Do not use
after expiration date.

Store at ambient conditions.
