Section 2: Hazard Identification

Section 4: First Aid Measures

Inhalation: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

Skin Contact: Wash skin with plenty of water and soap. Remove contaminated clothing. If irritation or rash occurs, seek medical advice.

Most Important Symptoms: Skin irritation, allergic skin reaction, aspiration hazard.

Advice for First Aiders: Wear protective gloves when administering first aid.

Section 5: Firefighting Measures

Extinguishing Media: Use carbon dioxide, dry chemical, or foam. Avoid water jets.

Specific Hazards: Combustible liquid. Vapors may form explosive mixtures with air.

Protective Equipment: Firefighters should wear self-contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing.

Flash Point: 60°C (closed cup)

Personal Precautions: Wear protective gloves and avoid inhalation of vapors. Ensure adequate ventilation.

Environmental Precautions: Prevent entry into waterways, sewers, or soil.
