

for 3-7 year olds



My name is Ros Gervay. I am an Australian abstract artist helping to serve the community by bringing original artworks and fine art prints into the homes of gorgeous people like you. I am also a primary school teacher and mum of two girls under five.

During this time of social-distancing, my beautiful daughters have really struggled with the fact that they need to keep their distance from people outside of our household. As a way to help my children stay connected to our lovely neighbours, show kindness & empathy, and express themselves, we came up with this activity. We made paper flowers to pop into our neighbours' letter boxes to bring them some happiness and let them know that even though they may not see us (or get a hug from us!), we are still here for them. And as a bonus, this activity is great for fine motor and listening skills!


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“Paper Flowers from the Heart” Art Activity Instructions



1. Gather your materials
You'll need 1 square piece of paper, ½ a pipe-cleaner, 2 large beads, scissors and a pen.



2. Fold your paper diagonally three times



3. Draw a petal shape on the paper, keeping the base of the petal at the centre of the square paper. Cut the shape out.



4. Cut a little off the tip (centre of the square paper).



5. Put one of the beads on the pipe-cleaner and twist to make sure it's secure.



6. Thread on the flower shape and the second bead.



7. And your flower is complete!
Now you can deliver them to your neighbours, friends or family members.
