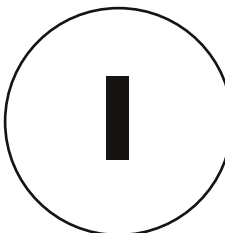




## Scaffoldings (DC15)

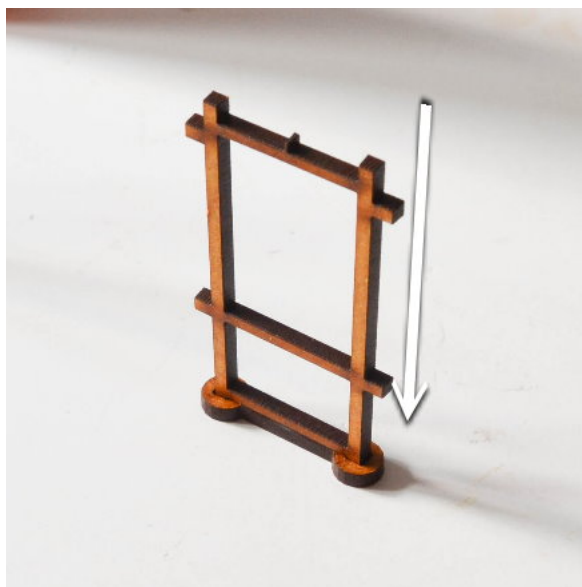
Read the instructions carefully before putting the kit together. The model can be glued with PVA glue. A file and a sharp hobby knife may be needed to remove the bits of the sprue from the parts



For the ground floor module, start with a pair of side railings with square studs at the bottom. You will need one piece with a small protrusion at the top and one without it.



Glue both of the side pieces to the base.

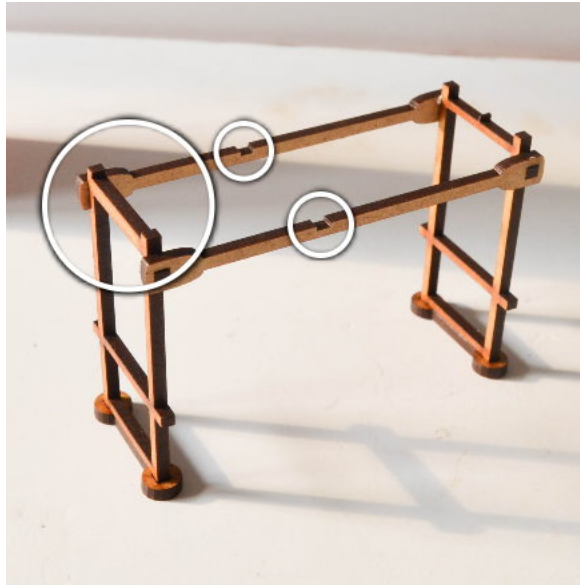


Take these two railings - note the small indentation around the middle.



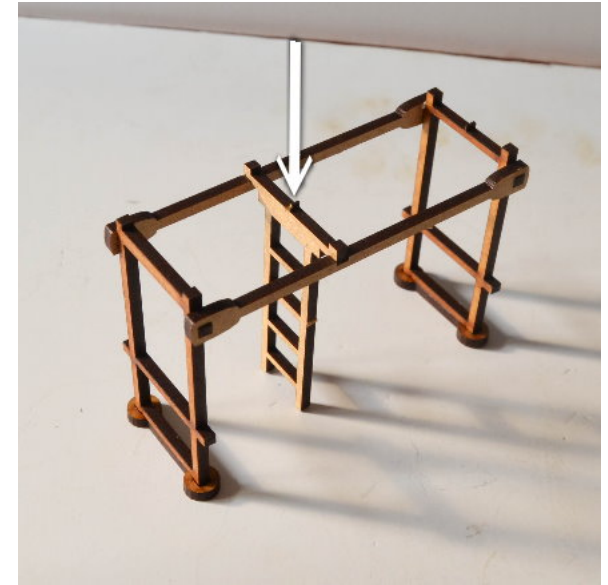

Glue them to the side pieces as shown. Note that the indentations should be closer to the piece without the small protrusion.

Glue the ladder into the indentations.



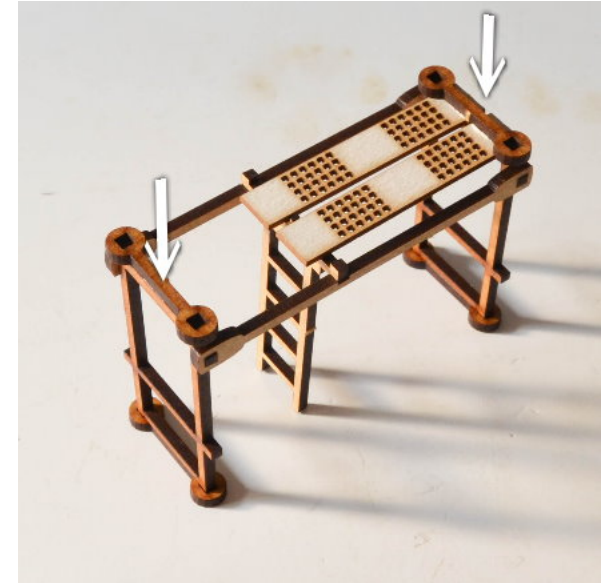

Add the two matte board pieces on top of the ladder and the side piece with protrusion.



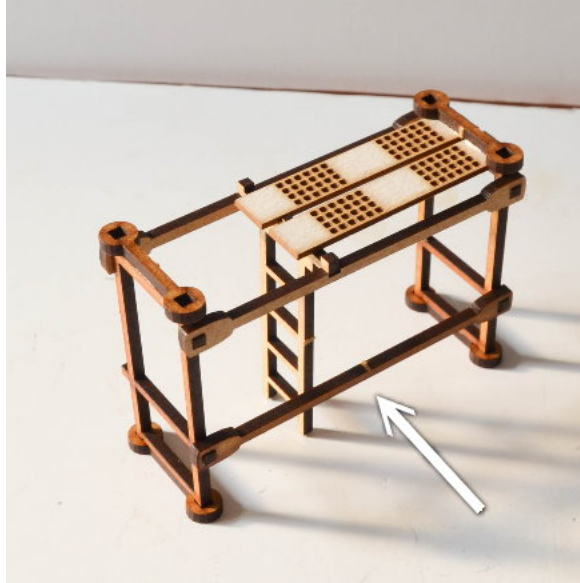

Cap both ends with the "base" pieces as shown.

Add the side railings. If you're using larger miniatures (32-35mm), you may want to leave one railing off to allow easier access.

For upper floor modules, repeat steps 1-8, but start with the side pieces with slanted studs at the end.
