To keep costs economical, we have resolved to order shirts in bulk and pass on the savings to our communities!

We will be doing safety shirt orders at least every summer.



A new process may evolve, as we constantly strive to serve your safety and needs throughout the year.

However, for the time being, please follow the steps below to order:

STEP 1:

Download the Safety Order Shirt

STEP 2:

Fill out the Safety Shirt Order Form

STEP 3:

Email completed form to your Regional Manager

DEADLINE:

Community Managers: Please submit your form(s) to your RM via email no later than by **June 7th.**

Regional Managers: Please approve and email to <u>reception@cwres.com</u> no later than June 14th.

Orders submitted after deadline may not be included

THEN WHAT?

Reception submits the bulk order June 17th.

Shirts will either be delivered by your Regional Manager, Company Picnic or mailed directly to you.

APPLICATION REMINDERS

As things start to pick back up, we just want to give a few application reminders:

• Always make a copy of the applicant's Photo ID and Social Security



number - this is a requirement when submitting an application.

- Make sure you double check that the applicant has completed the application in full before they leave your office. We need all applicable signatures in order to process the application.
- When looking over the application, make sure you verify that all things written on the application match up to the documents the applicant has provided.
- If possible, please upload application and supporting documents as one attachment to the uploader. When uploading, **DO NOT** select the forward to Origen box.
- Since we are storing sensitive applicant information, all applications, related information, and supporting documents need to be locked in a file cabinet at the end of each business day.

Please also ensure that you are using the updated application and charging the \$60 fee. We still occasionally receive outdated applications that charge a \$45 fee.

In an unprecedented move, PGE is offering a 15, 20 or 25 percent discount each month for two years to customers making 60 percent or less of the state median income.


