Available in either blue or red, the color is easily visible to help prevent bare spots from drift and reduce waste from over-spraying.

Solaron Marker Tint is non-hazardous and non-toxic to humans, animals and the environment. It's made specifically for temporary marking and will eventually fade with exposure to sunlight and moisture. It will not permanently stain human skin, vegetation or garden equipment.

Directions for Use

1. Plan Ahead

- For optimal results, apply under sunny conditions when no rain is forecast for 24 hours
- Avoid windy conditions to prevent drift and overspray.

2. Wear Protective Clothing

 When applying pesticides and fertilizers, always wear a long sleeve shirt, long pants and gloves.

3. Mix the Tint with Water

- Fill the tank halfway with water before adding the Solaron Marker Tint.
- Refer to the following table to measure the correct amount.
 Factors such as the color and height of vegetation, degree of water hardness, pH level or iron content may require different concentrations.
- Shake the tank to mix the tint and water thoroughly to ensure even color coverage.
- Mix enough to color the entire area before beginning application.

4. Apply Herbicide or Fertilizer per Manufacturer

Storage: Do not let the product freeze. Store in a cool dry place.

Disposal: Triple rinse empty plastic container and recycle.
