Dear Teacher,

Welcome to *Logos Cursive*, *Book 2: Proverbs* and *Sayings*. This schedule will help your second graders continue their cursive learning over the course of a semester doing one lesson per weekday (or over the course of a year, if you practice two to three times per week).

This book provides a fun twist to copy work from longtime Logos School principal Matt Whitling. At the school's weekly assemblies, Mr. Whitling will call out the first part of a saying, and the students will enthusiastically shout back the response. Many of the assembly sayings are taken from the book of Proverbs, but Mr. Whitling has thrown in a few other memorable quotes for good measure. If you want to try shouting them, say the part before the ellipsis (...) and have your student(s) shout back the rest.

Some of the sayings are very short, so students are to copy them multiple times. Help them be aware of that instruction.
