



The Potter's Center Class Agreement

1. Masks are required for all students. Please ensure that your masks fit your or your child's face appropriately so that your nose and mouth are covered. Our teaching staff will also be wearing masks. Masks will be worn for the duration of the class period.
2. In order to stop the spread of germs, we ask that you do not share tools or supplies with other students.
3. Our studio space will be set up to comply with social distancing standards. Please remember to keep a 6 foot distance from other students and our teaching staff at all times when able.
4. In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, we will NOT be supplying aprons or towels. You are free to bring your own apron or towel from home. Any apron or towel brought from your home cannot be shared or used by other students.
5. Pottery is messy, so please dress accordingly.
6. Your temperature will be taken via a handheld temperature gun upon entry. If you have a fever (any temperature above 99) you will be asked to leave.
7. You have 72 hours before week 1 begins to cancel and receive a full refund, so if you come to class with a fever, you will be asked to leave and you will not receive a refund.
8. Tools will be rented out for adult and teen classes. You will be charged for tools at the beginning of the class session and you will be refunded when tools are returned. You are free to take your rented tools home with you. If you would like to keep your tools at the studio, there will be space provided. If tools are left in our studio, we are not responsible for any loss or damages. There will be an option for you to buy tool sets at a discounted price.
9. You will need to bring plastic to cover your work. Dry cleaning bags are a great example or small garbage bags.
10. If tools are not returned, or returned damaged, you will not be refunded at the end of the course.

11. For childrens classes, the appropriate tools will be provided during each course.
Tools will be sanitized and deep cleaned.
