

## RING SIZE GUIDE

### I KNOW MY RING SIZE

If you already know your ring size but in a different country standard, simply refer to this ring size chart to find out the conversion to EU standard size.

If you're in between two sizes, it is best to order the next size up. For rings with a thick band, we recommend taking one size larger than your normal ring size.

### I HAVE A RING THAT FITS

Download this PDF and print it out in actual size ratio. You may double check the accuracy by using a ruler to measure out the actual distance written on the print out.

Take your favourite ring and place it over the ring circle table until you find one that matches the inside edge of the ring. When your ring has been placed on the right size, you should see only the grey circle—with no white space—inside your ring.

### I DON'T HAVE A RING

Cut a small piece of paper, thread or ribbon, wrap it around the base of the finger, just below the knuckle. Aim for a comfortable fit.

Mark the point where the end of the paper meets. Place the measured paper on a ruler, then match it with the inside circumference guide to find your appropriate ring size. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
