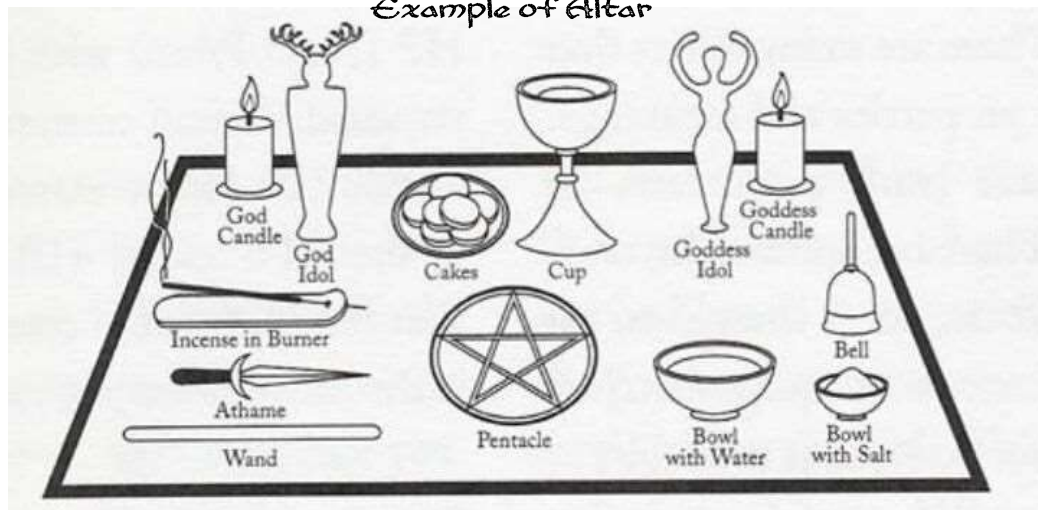


## Step by Step Guide to Petition Magic

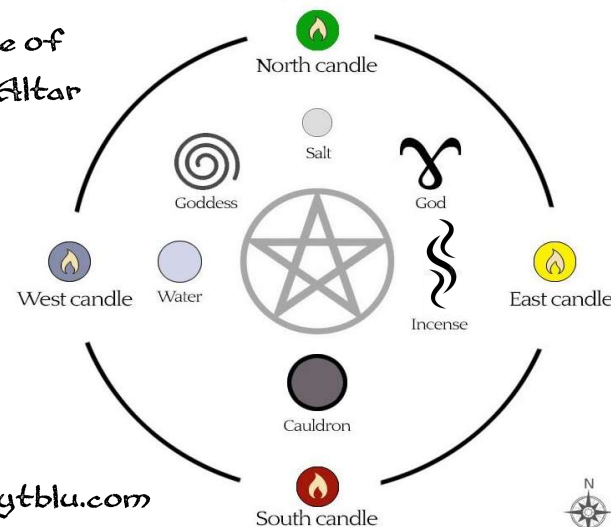
Petition Magic is a very common type of spell. Gather what supplies you will need, cast a full circle if this is the way you choose. Ground yourself, meditate or focus in whatever way you prefer. Dress or anoint your candle while focusing on your goal (put one drop of oil on the candle and gently rub it on). Light the candle and invoke your deity. Continue to meditate on your goal. Take your paper and write your petition (your intention of the spell). If you wish, add things to the paper, herbs, oils, hair, etc.). State your intention asking your deities for help, light the paper on the candle, and place it in a safe dish. Close your eyes and continue to visualize your petition coming to fruition. Thank your deity and complete your ritual and close your circle.

Heed the flower, bush, and tree by the Lady blessed you'll be.

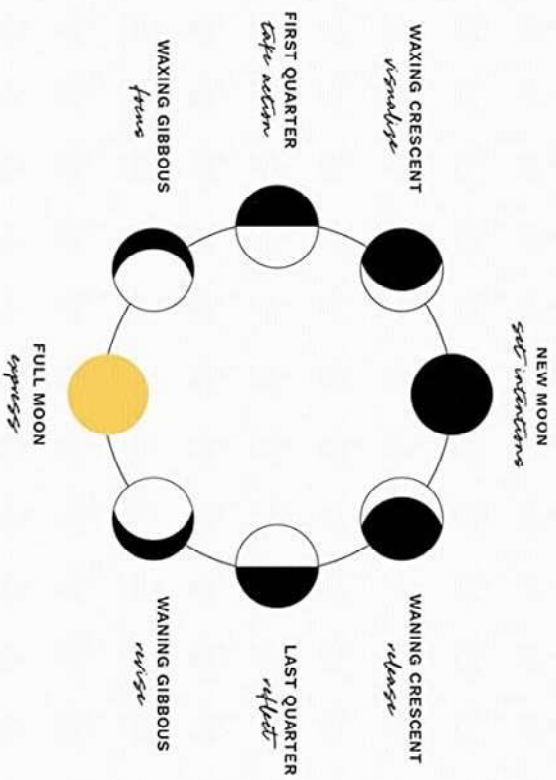
Where the rippling waters go cast a stone, the truth you'll know.

Merry Meet and Merry Part bright the cheeks and warm the heart.

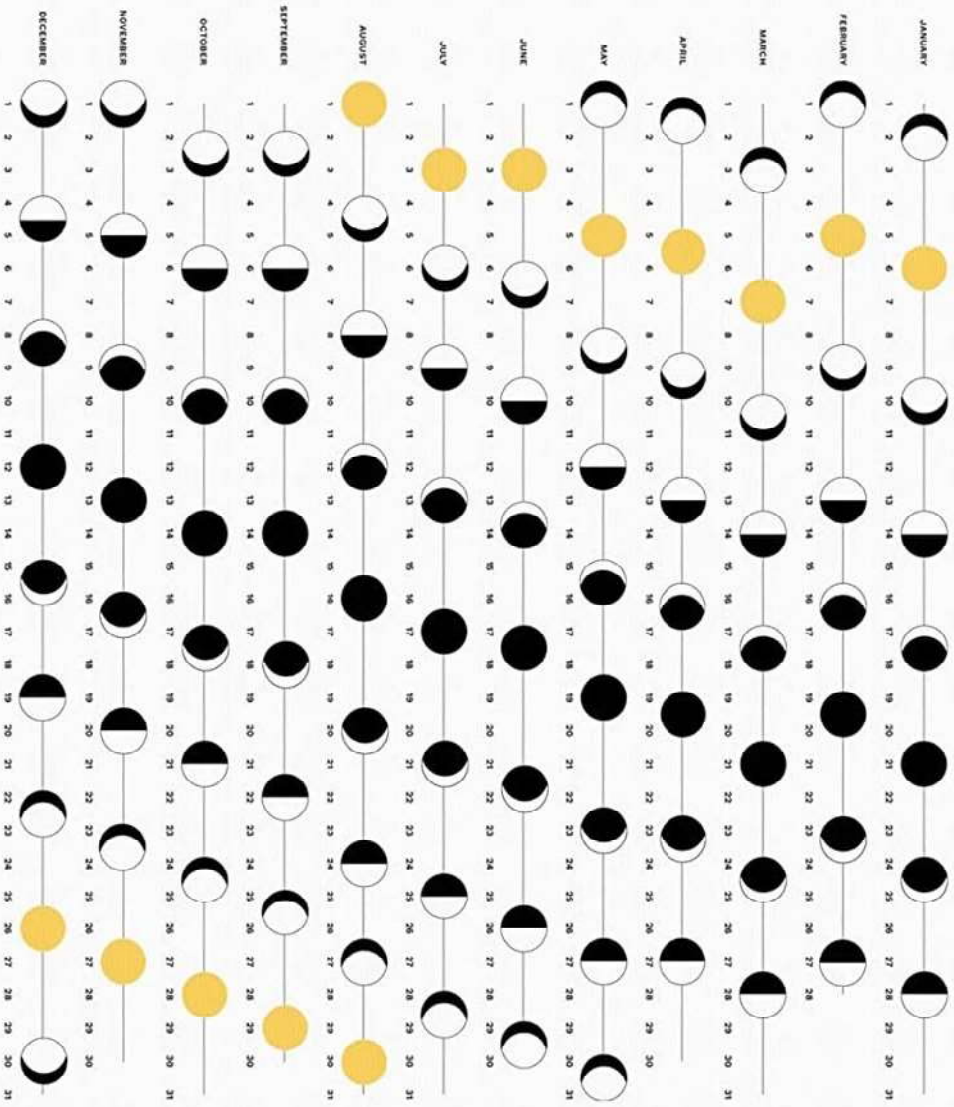

# Witches Runes

	<b>Crossroads.</b> Use this symbol in magic if you are going through a big change or if you wish to bring change to your life, or if you have a decision to make.
	<b>Man:</b> Use this symbol in magic workings that deals with men or masculinity, use it to draw on strength or the power of the Gods.
	<b>Woman:</b> Use this symbol in your magical working to represent woman, or the feminine, or to call upon the Goddesses.
	<b>The Eye:</b> The eye is a very magical symbol, use this symbol for psychic workings, or in spells to find out the truth or to find out if someone is being dishonest, also use for protection.
	<b>Harvest:</b> This symbol should be used for prosperity and abundance. Use it in magical workings dealing with money, or bringing something good into your life.
	<b>The Sun:</b> This symbol represents growth and happiness, strength and the masculine, use this for invoking Sun Gods and Goddesses. Use this symbol for protection and happiness, or on Sabbats.
	<b>The Moon:</b> This symbol represents the feminine and magic. Use this symbol on any magical workings to enhance the power, use it to invoke Moon Goddesses and on Esbats.
	<b>Flight:</b> This witches rune symbol represents higher knowledge, if you wish to learn something new or want to start a new business or success at a new job then use this symbol to attract it.
	<b>The Rings:</b> Use this symbol for binding, if you wish to attract new love or if you are in a relationship, this will strengthen the bond, in business use this symbol to strengthen a contract.
	<b>Romance:</b> This Rune is to attract romance or a new love to you, use this symbol in sex magic or fertility, also used to heal broken hearts and relationships.
	<b>The scythe:</b> This symbol is used to break curses or bad luck. If you feel you have a curse or hex over you use this symbol to break it. It can also be used for breaking a bond in a relationship.
	<b>The Star:</b> This is the wishing Rune. If there is something you desire, use this symbol to attract it to you, meditate on this symbol to bring luck and fortune to you.
	<b>Waves:</b> This Rune symbol is used for purity, use this for forgiveness or to wash away bad or negative feelings. This is a strong symbol for healing, addiction or depression.

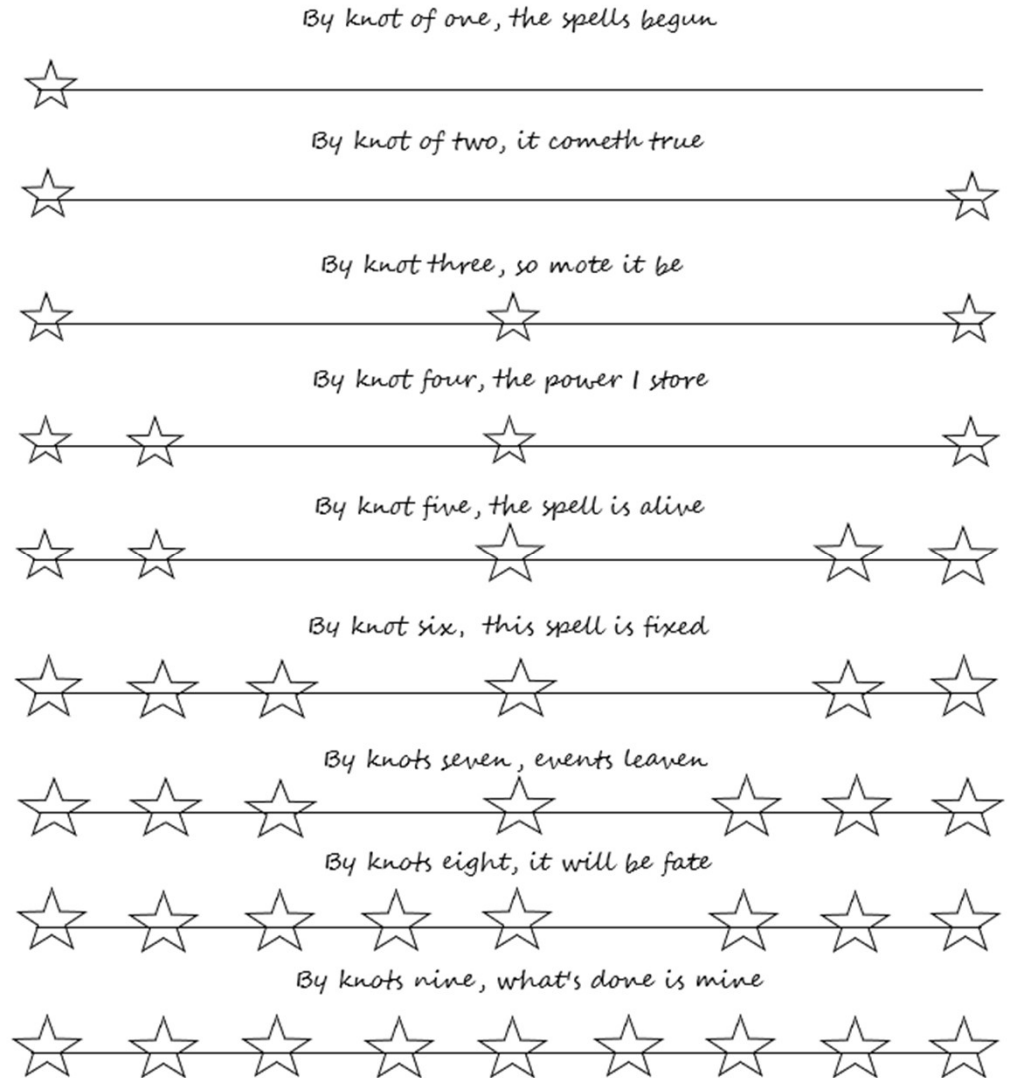
## The Witches Ladder

The Witches Ladder is spell casting old witchcraft style. You will need 3 pieces of ribbon, string, rope or cords and charms, beads, feathers, twigs or anything you choose. Purify your items prior to beginning. Take your time and focus on your intention. Set this goal and keep it in your mind throughout the process. Visualize your goal being accomplished in as many ways as possible. Tie your three ribbons together at the top. This knot will bind your intention. Stay focused on your goal. Begin tying your knots, add charms and tokens as you see fit. If it does not have a hole to thread, tie it directly to the ribbon. While weaving, use this standard knot chant. You will be tying nine knots, save one charm for the final knot.

By knot of one, the spell's begun.  
By knot of two, the magic comes true.  
By knot of three, so it shall be.  
By knot of four, this power is stored.  
By knot of five, my will shall drive.  
By knot of six, the spell I fix.  
By knot of seven, the future I leaven.  
By knot of eight, my will be fate.  
By knot of nine, what is done is mine.

Then seal the spell by stating "So Mote It Be"  
Hang your Witches Ladder where you can see it daily, this will give it the most capability to do it's work. Once your goal has been obtained, either bury it in the ground, burn it or throw it into moving water to release the spell.

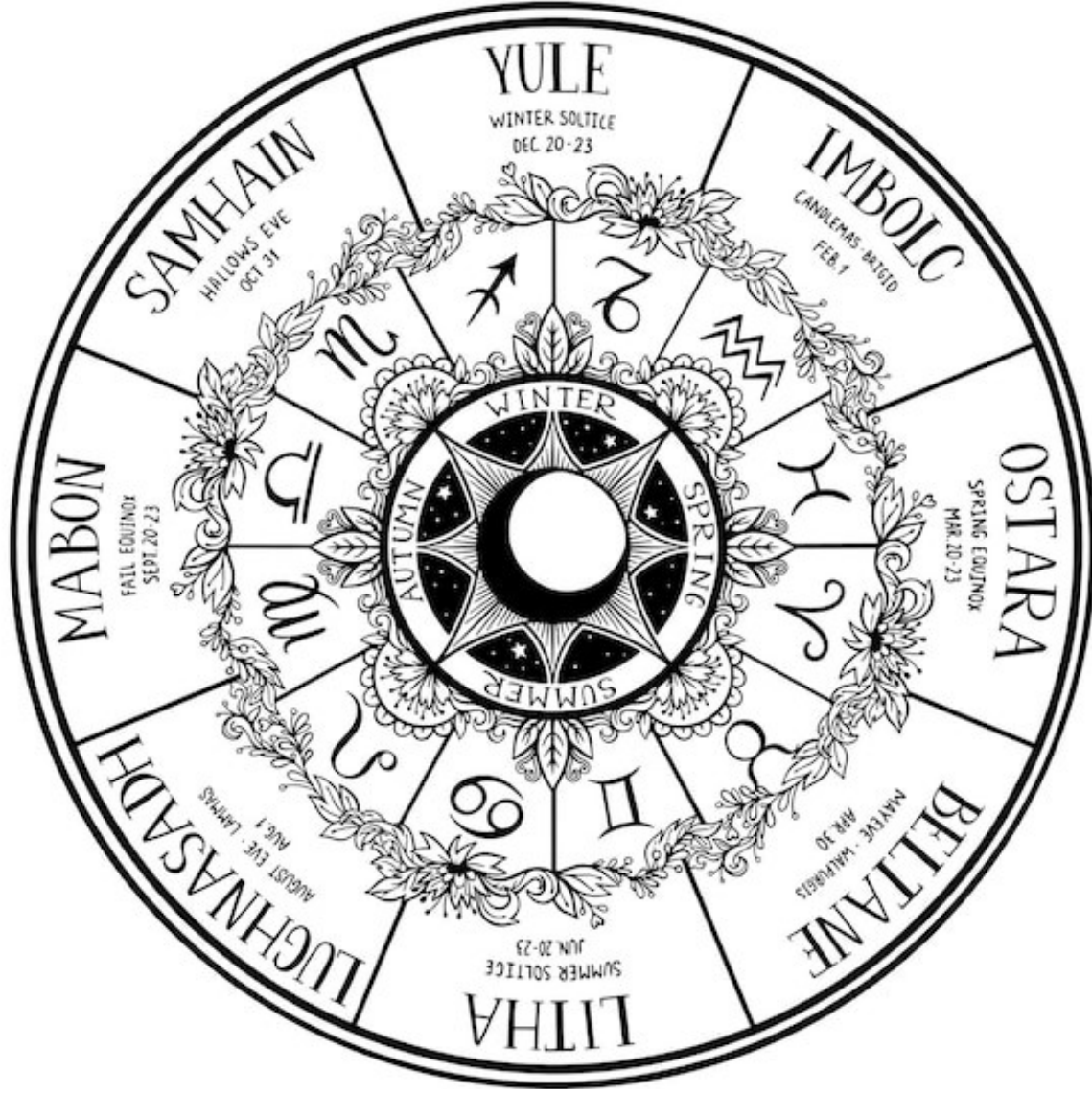

## Detailed Listing and Use of Altar Tools

*(the kit you received may or may not include all of these items – this is for general information)*

**Altar Box** – A wooden box used to hold some of your smaller tools and supplies.

**Athame** – Associated with the Fire Element. The Athame is a double edged ritual knife and is used to direct energy, cutting unwanted ties, drawing the sacred circle before ritual and closing it afterward, drawing symbols in the air and drawing symbols in candles, harvesting herbs used in Spell Work, and handcrafting wands. The Athame is not used to cut anything on the physical plane items noted above and has very masculine qualities and also represents the God.

**Wand** – Associated with the Air Element. A wand can be made of natural material. Wands can be used for divination and channeling Magick energy casting spells, casting and recalling circles and in some cases can be used in lieu of an Athame. The Wand is placed on the South of your Altar.

**Chalice** – Associated with the Water Element and the Goddess. It is a symbol of fertility and abundance. With the Chalice you offer libations to the deities and partake in cakes and ale ceremony. The Chalice may hold wine, ale, saltwater or water but frequently will stand empty as a symbol of opening yourself to the abundance pouring forth from the spiritual plane. Chalices are usually made of metal or metal and glass combination. You should only rinse your Chalice with water, never chemicals or polish. The Altar Chalice is placed in the West, the direction of Water.

**Deities** – Images or representations of any Goddesses or Gods that are special to you should be included in your Altar, however they are not considered Altar Tools, respectively. A Coin, Symbol or Statue of your chosen Deity is suitable as representation.

**Altar Tile** – Associated with the Earth Element. Altar tiles can be placed on Altars usually with symbols such as the Pentacle. They are used in rituals and spells and are used as a vessel to hold energy including spirits.

**Cauldron** – A vessel to hold offerings to the God or Goddesses during ritual, also a vessel to receive offerings from the Gods or Goddesses. A Chalice or Cauldron both can be used for this purpose. Prepare herbs, flowers, oils and anything needed in your ritual as an offering. When finished, bury or pour your offerings into the Earth or into living water to carry them to the Divine.

**Bell** – Bells are to get the attention of the deity you are calling. A bell can also be used to clear negative energy. Many ring their Altar Bells prior to a ritual and afterward.

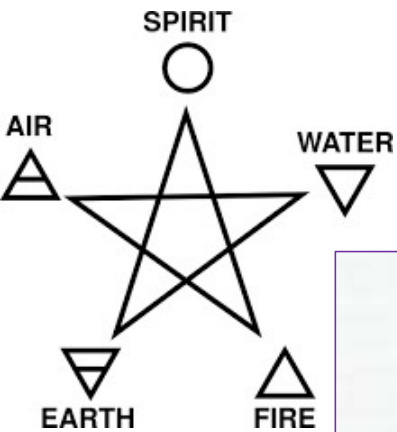
**Pentacle** – This is a 5 pointed star within a circle, and placed in the center of your Altar. The Pentacle is one of the most important Altar Tools as it offers power and protection in spell work.

**Altar Cloth** – An Altar Cloth is a useful but not necessary tool and is primarily used to set the stage for the energy of your Altar.

**Smudge Stick** – A smudge stick is used to cleanse the Altar and nearby area prior to any rituals.

**Quartz Crystal** – Associated with the Earth Element and is placed on the North of your Altar. Crystals bring Earth energy and assists in grounding. Amethyst is often used as a power enhancer for spells and clear quartz is specifically used to sharpen focus of ritual work.

**Feather** – Associated with the Element of Air. The feather is placed in the East on your Altar. Feathers can be used to cleanse energy and fan incense or smudge smoke.

## House Protection Jar

1 glass jar, 1/2 to 1 cup salt, 3 cloves garlic, 9 bay leaves,  
7 tsp. dried Basil, 4 tsp. dill seeds, 1tsp sage, 1tsp anise,  
1tsp black pepper, 1tsp fennel, 1 bowl.

In the morning ideally on a bright sunny day assemble the items.

Place in the bowl and say:

"Salt that protects, protect my home and all within."

Add the cloves of garlic:

"Garlic that protects, protect my home and all within."

Crumble the Bay leaves and place in the bowl:

"Bay that protects, protect my home and all within."

Add the basil and say: "Basil that protects,  
protect my home and all within."

Add the dill and say: "Dill that protects,  
protect my home and all within."

Add the sage and say: "Sage that protects,  
protect my home and all within."

Add the anise and say: "Anise that protects,  
protect my home and all within."

Add the fennel and say: "Fennel that protects,  
protect my home and all within."

Mix together the salt and the herbs with your hands, throughout  
the movement of your hands and fingers lend energy to  
the potent protective items, visualize your home safe  
and as a shining secure place. Pour the mixture in the jar  
and cap tightly. Place it in your home with these words:

"Salt and herbs, nine times nine Guard now this home of mine"

## Connect with a Deceased Loved One

You will need:

- A framed picture of your loved one – human or animal
- A black candle – and something to light it with
- A sweetgrass braid and a burning dish

Sweetgrass will not only protect from negative entities and energy, the smoke will create a doorway for beneficent spirits to enter. Smudge entire room with the braid in a clockwise direction – NOT widdershins (counterclockwise). Then extinguish it in a jar of water.)

Now sit in front of the photo and place the black candle near it, light the candle, look at the photo of your loved one while relaxing and meditating. The key here is to focus. When you feel you are ready, close your eyes and connect with your loved one. Continue to relax and try and establish a connection on the interdimensional realm. Try and feel or sense their presence. Sit in peace and spend time with them, keeping them in your thoughts. At this point you should feel them near you just as they would be if they were in the physical realm. When you feel satisfied, thank them for joining you take three deep breaths and open your eyes. Note: If you feel a strong presence, you may ask one question and as the answer, ask they show you a sign within the next three days.

## Protect Your Home from Unfriendly Spirits

Samhain is the time when spirits are most active among us, however spirits are always among us. If you are a receptive spirit yourself, it is important not to open doorways for negative spirits who will use us as a doorway for malevolent work. It is time to protect your home and yourself from these unseen spirits that you would rather not have lingering around uninvited. You will need:

- 9 cloves of garlic
- A half-pint mason jar
- Olive oil

Empower the garlic by holding it in bright sunlight for a minute or two. Peel and roughly chop the garlic and place it in the mason jar. Fill the jar with olive oil and stir with a chopstick or any wooden utensil 9 times in a clockwise direction. Leave overnight outside.

The next morning as the sun is rising, lightly anoint the outside of your front door with the oil. Then move in a clockwise direction around your space, lightly anointing every window and door with the oil.

You can save the remainder of the oil for future protective use. For example, you can anoint your third eye with the oil to keep unsavory entities at bay while traversing potentially haunted places or spiritually treacherous situations. You can also anoint photographs of people you would like to protect.

## Gypsy Money Drawing Spell

You will need:

- A ceramic bowl
- 5 small red candles
- Cinnamon stick – for prosperity
- Allspice – for success
- Handful of spare change.


The change represents your “seed” money. Whatever you have in your pocket, or in the bottom of your purse will do. Put the money, the cinnamon stick, one of the red candles in the bowl. Sprinkle the candle and the money with a generous pinch of allspice. As you sprinkle the allspice say the following:

Trinka five  
Trinka five  
My money magic  
Comes alive!

Light the candle and allow it to burn all the way down. The next day, remove the spent candle and add any spare change that you may have accumulated. Remember to say “thank you.” Now, put the second red candle on top of the money, sprinkle the allspice, and say the charm.

Do this for five days in a row, and your money magic will be activated, empowered, recharged, and amplified.
