



UV DTF Transfer Film

Instructions / Application Guide



Place

Peel and place DTF Transfer Film A sheet on table, sticky side facing up.

Secure flat to surface with tape or vacuum table.




Print

Recommended printing order:


- 3. Gloss
- 2. CMYK
- 1. White

(White underbase optional, multiple passes of Gloss for extra height effects.)




Laminate

Get rid of bubbles to ensure bonding between prints on Film A and Film B using laminator (hot or cold).




Squeegee

Cut to size and apply Transfer Mask Film B to prints on Film A. Get rid of bubbles to ensure bonding using squeegee.



Cut

Cut prints into indivual pieces.



Peel

Carefully remove Film A by peeling away from Film B. Check that all parts of print are sticking to Film B.



Firmly press print to clean surface and peel

away gently. If worried about adhesion, clean surface with Isopropyl Alcohol or your preferred cleaning product.



Enjoy

Let UV Transfer rest on surface for 24 hrs before testing adhesion.
