


Culminating Project Choices

Now that you have completed *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*, choose one of these final projects to do!

- I. <u>SEQUEL</u>: Write a sequel to the book. What happens after the ending?
- 2. <u>CANDY REPORT</u>: Research all about a famous candy. Write an informational report about it.
- CANDY INVENTION: Mr. Wonka is famous for his candy inventions. Think of your own candy invention. Create an advertisement for your candy.
- 4. <u>PLAYWRIGHT:</u> Choose your favorite scene(s) from the story. Write it in the form of a play. Either record it to show to the class, or perform it in front of the class!
- BOARD GAME: Create a board game which is themed around the novel. Be creative!
- 6. NEWS INTERVIEW: Imagine you are a news reporter that is interviewing one of the characters from the novel. Write a script for it. With a partner, either record it to show to the class, or perform it in front of the class!
- CHOCOLATE REPORT: Research all about how chocolate is made. Write an informational report about it.
- MOVIE POSTER: Design a movie poster advertising a movie based on the book.
- 9. <u>CHARACTER ART</u>: Create sculptures, puppets, or models of the characters using any material you choose. You could use a combination of paper, rocks, clay, poster board, old toys, sticks, or anything you can think of!
- CHOCOLATE FACTORY BROCHURE: Create a travel brochure describing the different wondrous parts of the factory.


