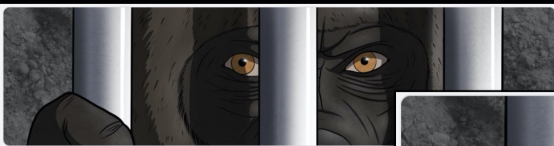

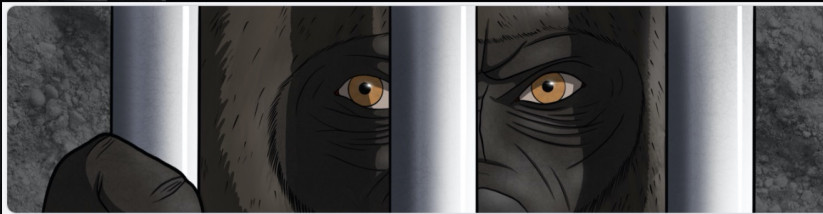

Character Analysis: He lives in a mall. His closest friends are Stella (an elephant) and Bob (a dog). He doesn't ever feel angry. He is pretty complacent and used to his life in his cage.

Comprehension and Analysis:

- Ivan thinks that humans talk too much, and that they make lots of constant noise even when they have nothing to say. He also thinks that humans are not very patient, unlike gorillas. INSTRUCTIONS FOR *Google Forms* COMPREHENSION & VOCABULARY CHECKS

1. To get started, you will need to have access to the Internet and a Google account (which is free). Before moving on, be sure you are signed into the Google account that you want the resources to transfer into.

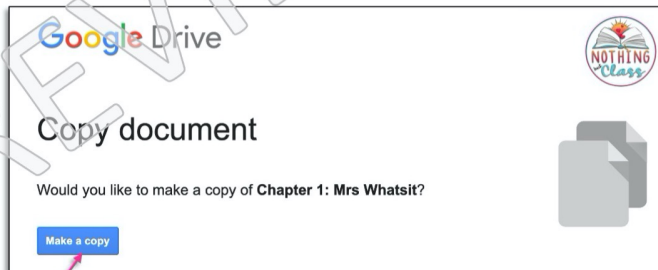
