



Culminating Project Choices

Now that you have completed the book, choose one of the final projects to do below!

- 1. <u>SEQUEL</u>: Write a sequel to <u>Charlotte's Web</u>. What happens to the Wilbur and his friends?
- <u>WHO'S THE AUTHOR?</u>: Use the Internet to do research about the author, E.B. White. Write a biography about him. Make sure to include a Works Cited page.
- 3. <u>DEAR DIARY</u>: Choose a character in the book. Write about the events in the book from his or her point of view, in the form of several diary entries.
- H. <u>NEWSPAPER</u>: Create a newspaper that is themed around the events in the book. You might include articles, advertisements, comic strips, and an advice column.
- 5. <u>PLAYWRIGHT</u>: Choose your favorite scene(s) from <u>Charlotte's Web</u>. Write it in the form of a play. Either record it to show to the class, or perform it in front of the class!
- 6. <u>BOARD GAME</u>: Create a board game which is themed around <u>Charlotte's Web</u>. Be creative!
- 7. <u>NEWS INTERVIEW</u>: Imagine you are a journalist that is interviewing one of the characters from <u>Charlotte's Web</u>. Write a script for it. With a partner, either record it to show to the class, or perform it in front of the class!
- 8. <u>ALL ABOUT SPIDERS</u>: Do some more research about spiders. Present your findings in a creative way. You might create a Power Point presentation, make a poster, or write an essay. It's your choice.
- 9. <u>MOVIE POSTER</u>: Design a movie poster advertising a movie based on <u>Charlotte's</u> <u>Web.</u>
- 10. <u>CHARACTER ART</u>: Create sculptures, puppets, or models of the characters using any material you choose. You could use a combination of paper, rocks, clay, poster board, old toys, sticks, or anything you can think of!
