



WARNING


- This Bivvy Bag is NOT fireproof and will burn in seconds if exposed to flame or excessive heat.
- Do not cook in your Bivvy Bag.
- Do not place hot appliances close to the walls or roof of your Bivvy Bag, observe safety warnings for any appliances and do not allow children to play near them.
- Keep exits of Bivvy Bag free from obstructions and woodland creatures, they will steal your food.
- Maintain adequate ventilation at all times, death by suffocation is possible. Always store any cheesy socks in vestibules or outside the Bivvy Bag.
- Anchor your Bivvy Bag carefully at all times: the use of pegs is recommended, anchors are very heavy.
- Choose your campsite wisely, be aware of the possibility of falling rocks and trees, lightning, flash floods, avalanches and airborne whales.
- Using an additional footprint/tarp provides extra protection if pitching on rough or boggy ground,

PITCHING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure the ground is free from sharp objects and rocks that may damage your groundsheet.
2. Lay the Bivvy Bag on the ground and peg it out at the bottom two corners. Assemble the two poles and thread them through the pole sleeves. [Fig 1]



3. Align the pole ends with the metal eyelets at the ends of the pole sleeve. [Fig 2]
4. Erect the canopy by carefully pushing into the sleeves from the other end, it does not matter which pole is first.







- Peg out the four pole ends to keep the tension and position of the Bivvy Bag.
- Peg out the rear rain cover flap, maintaining good tension and a steep angle for effective rain runoff. [Fig 3]



- When you are set up, consider airflow through the Bivvy Bag. It is important to maintain good airflow for comfort and effectiveness in reducing condensation.
- Use the mesh zipped panel by the opening to prevent suffocation and improve airflow.

FIELD REPAIRS

- If you are unlucky enough to rip your Bivvy Bag, duct tape or StormSure tough tape will do the trick for field repairs.
- When you are home and dry, you can repair your Bivvy Bag properly. Using the Spares kit you can patch up your Bivvy Bag with more fabric. Remember to seal any seams!
- If a pole breaks, use a pole splint or sleeve as a temporary repair.
- If you need any help of spare parts then please get in touch and we will find a fix for your Bivvy Bag.



 Inner mesh: 20d Nylon Breathable ripstop
 Floor: 70d Nylon, 210t ripstop (HH: 5,000mm)
 Poles: 7001-T6 alloy (7.9mm diameter)
 Pegs: 7 pegs, Alpkit Y-Beams
 Other: Zips: YKK, Anodised metal eyelets.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Clean and dry Bivvy Bag thoroughly after each use.
- Never use a washing machine or tumble dryer to clean your Bivvy Bag. Car washes are also frowned upon.
- Spot clean with mild detergent and warm water.
- Air dry only.
- Pack Bivvy Bag carefully to avoid punctures.
- Avoid prolonged UV exposure.
