





Place the Lioness retaining straps underneath the handlebar, just outboard of the Mountain Lion straps.


The camlock should be towards the front of the bike.


Take the free end of the strap and loop it over the top of the bar towards the rear. Thread it through the square loop and back over the top of the bar and through the camlock.

Pull tight and close the camlock.

Place Lioness in position on the front of the dry bag and clip the top buckles of the Lioness into the retaining straps.

Adjust the top straps to vertically position Lioness.

Clip the bottom strap buckles into the retaining straps.

Make a final check on position and strap tension, ensuring that Lioness sits squarely on the bike.

Note: When removing Lioness, unclip the bottom buckles first to prevent the bag from falling on to the front wheel.
