New for 2019, *Peace Works* all-inclusive summer camp curriculum resource features materials for a full week's worth of activities for five different age levels, including:

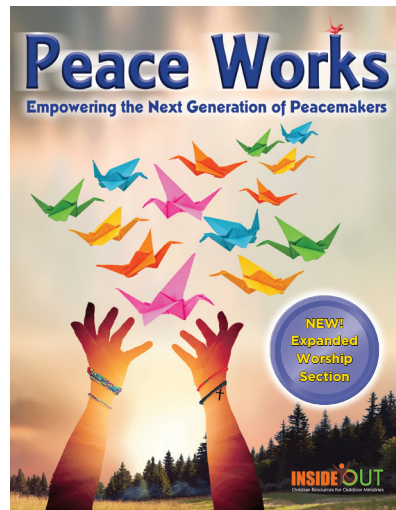
- Bible study centered on the biblical call for justice and peacemaking work
