## Instructions for: **Rittel's Blood Eater**

Rittel's Blood Eater is a relaxing and blood – eater agent. It is ideal for rehydrating the bloody capes and skins. It has excellent protein attacking abilities (an affinity to dispersing blood). It can either be used by itself or in conjunction with your normal relaxing bath. Keep in mind that very little is needed to effectively relax and clean your capes or skins. It is also an excellent choice for cleaning bloody bird skins too!

For normal usage – use 2 oz. of Blood Eater to every 5 gallons of water needed to completely submerge your capes or skins. If you weigh your skins, use 2 quarts of water for every 1 pound. Example: 5 gallons of solution should easily relax 10 pounds of skin-weight. Leave the skins in this solution until they are rehydrated and flexible. Usually most salt dried capes fully relax within 4-8 hours.

When using Blood Eater with your current relaxing bath, it is recommended to add either Ultra Soft or another relaxing agent to the bath by 1 oz. to every 5 gallons of water.

Leave the skins or capes in this solution until they relax completely. When fully relaxed – remove, rinse, inspect for any blood spots still visible, scrub with relaxing solution if necessary, and then rinse again. Place into the pickling solution.
