Instructions for:

Feather White

Feather White can be successfully used to lighten, brighten, and in most cases, do away with stained blumage on waterfowl and upland game birds without damage to the feathers.

Moisten stained area with water.

Using a soft applicator, like a piece of cotton, apply moderate amount of **Feather White** to cotton and stroke across the stain. Movein the direction of the feathers. Stain should begin to lighten immediately. For stubborn stains, repeat as often as necessary.

Rine Feather White from plumage after using.

CAUTION: Feather White is an acid and it is recommended to wear rubber gloves when using this product. Avoid contact with skin: rinse for several minutes in cool water. Avoid swallowing: if ingested, drink large amounts of milk or water. Avoid contact with eyes: flush with cool water for 15 minutes. Contains hydrofluoric acid.
