Instructions for:
Premium Mache

Our mache is a dextrine based, plaster mache formulated for day-to-day shop use. Mache can be used to build up around skull plates on game heads, base work, antler mounts, as well as thousands of other uses. Mache dries to a light colored, rock hard cement which resists shrinking, cracking, or chipping.

DIRECTIONS

Mix mache with room temperature water for best results, warm water will accelerate set time, while cold water will retard set time. Mache consistency should be fairly firm, too much water will cause mache to sag. Do not mix more than you can use within a 20-30 minutes time period. Once the desired consistency has been achieved, work mache with a putty knife, trowel, or wet hand.

SET TIME

The set time is approximately 30 minutes. You may speed up the set time by adding a small amount of salt, or you can slow the set time with the addition of small amounts of borax. Experiment to achieve a dry time that will coincide with your project.

Clean hands and tools with soap and water.
