

## **Turkey Leg Diagram**



Cut off the knob of the leg bone, so that the leg bone is small enough in diameter to slip through the hole of the artificial drumstick.

This artificial drumstick is designed to be used just as a wrapped leg would be used. A no. 6 wire is ran through the leg and then wired or zip tied to the leg bone. The artificial drumstick is then slipped over the bone and the no. 6 wire. Make sure that your wire or zip tie is small enough to slip over the hole of the artificial drumstick. The lower area of the drumstick should be made of clay so there is a smooth union of the artificial drumstick and the ankle area of the turkey. Make sure not to use too much clay or this will make the leg skin difficult to pull over the clay area. If the artificial drumstick is too long, simply cut off the bottom area of the artifical drumstick with a knife and fill in this area with clay. Push the sharpened no. 6 wire through the turkey body, bend and secure wire in body and mount bird.
