

NEW PATCH CABLES ALERT

EVER HEARD OF TOUR GEAR DESIGN CABLES ?

IT'S NOT JUST ANOTHER CABLE ! IT'S ONE THAT WILL MAKE YOUR BOARD BETTER !

Did you know that a poor quality cable can ruin your tone, and your rig? But why, how? you may ask. First, the looks, for sure. Lengths of cables that are just hanging there aren't pretty, but they also raise the chances of unwanted stumble or getting stuck in a sea of cable.

When people reach to us for pedals acting weird, noising or not really doing what one had been dreaming of, cables and power supplies are often the main suspects. Why? you may ask again. Because cheap cables, or cables with outside conductive parts (metal) can mess up with the chakras or your board, if not create some short-circuit. Some not-so-cheap cables can also turn out to have a surprisingly short life span (see picture of a popular brand patch cable).

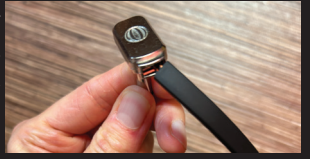
Because a great tone is our first mission, yeah, our pedals aren't worth much if they sound like crap, we decided to ditch the very cheap patch cables and collaborate with Flat Gear Design.

We have them in 3", 4", 6" 15" and in 3-pack of 3", for now in 'C' shape only. We are also considering 'S' shape because it's so useful to have a jack on each side for side-to-top connect. Let us know what you'd like!
