- Don't approach a dog.

 Let them approach you.
- Don't bother a dog when they eat, sleep, drink, or play with their friends.
- Practice consent checks.

 Calmly pet the dog for 3 seconds, then remove your hands.

- Don't hug or kiss a dog.
- Don't sit, lay on, or ride a dog.
- **6 Don't stare at a dog.**

- Don't pet a dog on top of their head, instead try their chin or butt.
- Don't punish a dog.

Read a dog's body
language and
understand when they
need space.

- Eat at higher tables rather than lower, where a dog's nose might be.
- If you leave the table, push the food to the center or take the food to a higher counter.
- Hold your food up high in the sky if a dog passes.

- Before you open any door, look at your feet and nearby for escape artists.
- Shut all doors behind you, especially where the toys are!
- Never take anything from a dog's mouth.
