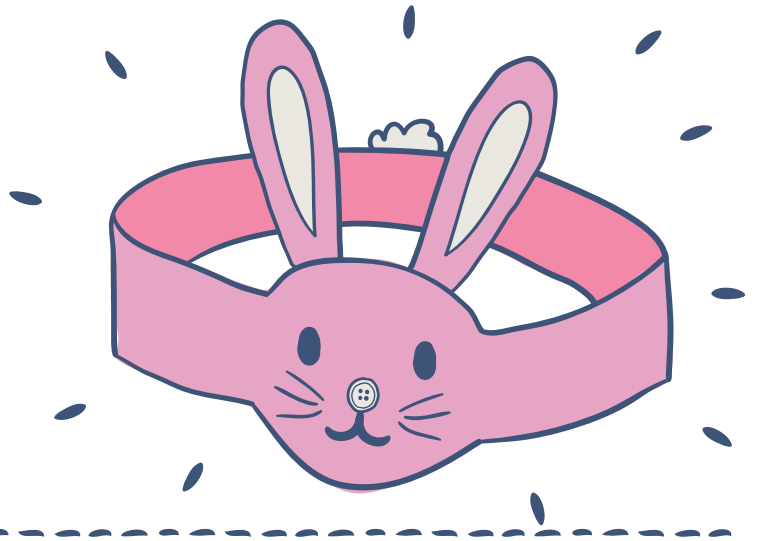


Bunny headband

Look like a bunny this Easter whilst you hunt for eggs with this fun, home-made headband.

What you need:

- Scissors
- Black marker pen
- Stapler or sticky tape
- Craft glue
- Pom-pom or cotton ball (optional)
- Coloured or patterned card (optional)
- Button (optional)



Instructions:

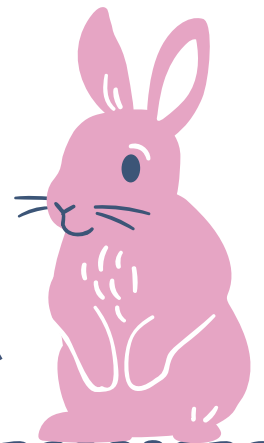
Step 1: Print out the Easter bunny headband template and cut out the pieces.

Step 2: Take the inner sections of the bunny ears and glue them on top of the outer bunny ear sections.

Step 3: Glue the bunny ears onto the back of the bunny head and then create your bunny face with your marker pen and optional button for the nose.

Step 4: Take the band (back) section and staple or sticky tape it to the bunny face (front) section to create a circular headband. Make sure it's the right size before you glue it.

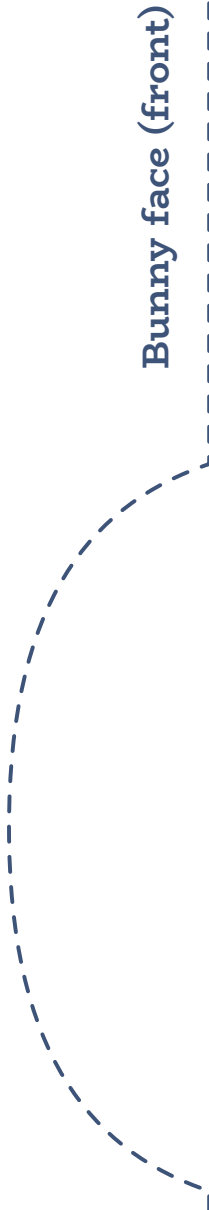
Step 5: Glue your pom-pom or cotton ball to the back of the band to complete your bunny.



Top tips:

- Use an old button for the bunny's nose or draw a cute face using whatever you have to hand.
- You can decorate the pieces of your headband before you glue it together or draw around your templates onto patterned card.
- No printer? Try drawing the sections using our template as a visual guide.

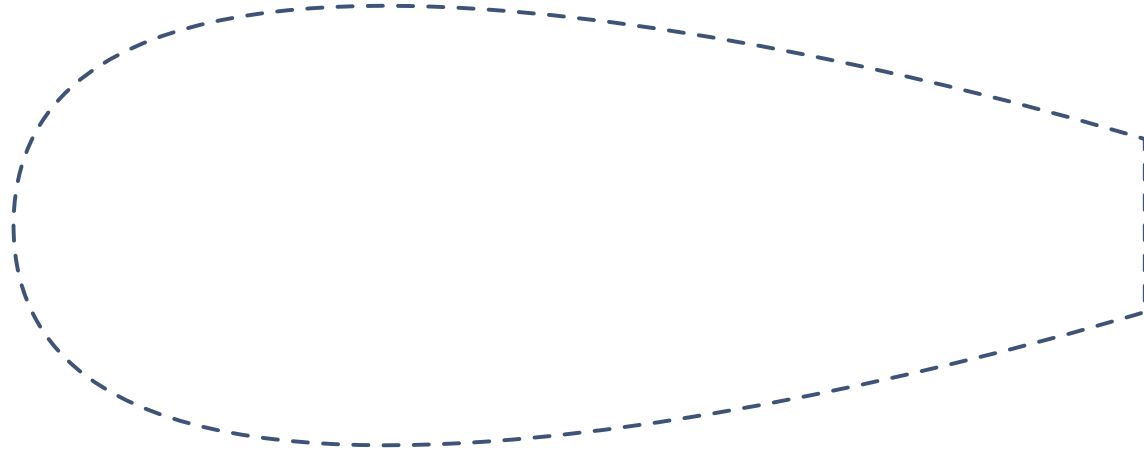


Bunny face (front)

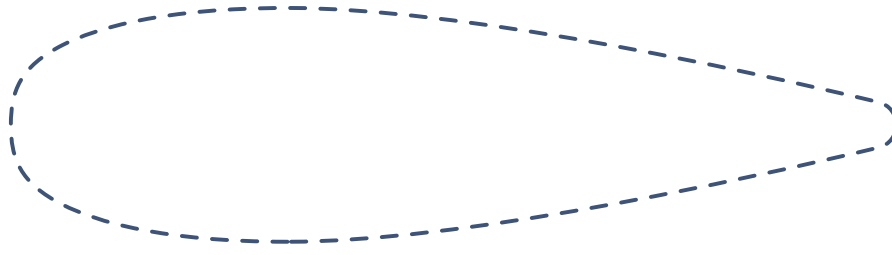
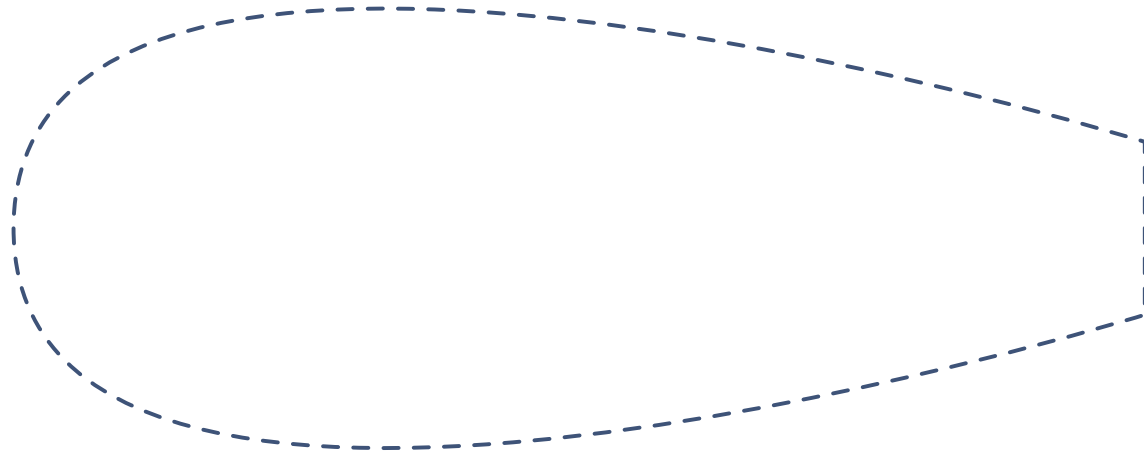


Band (back)
