# MAKE FROM A KIT

Our **Full Maker Kits** come with all of the ingredients you need to make your bag: pre-cut fabric, ready-to-attach leather, and all of the necessary hardware. **Leather + Hardware Kits** contain everything but the fabric, for makers who prefer to source their own.

## ESSENTIAL TOOLS

- **Tubular Rivet Peening Tool** necessary to set tubular rivets
- □ Line 24 Snap Setter + Dot Anvil to set Line 24 snaps
- Drive Punch for punching holes in leather and fabric
- **Cutting Board** to use under metal punching tools
- □ **Non-rubber Mallet** heavy-duty enough for tubular rivets
- Hard Setting Surface slab of stone, metal anvil, concrete

## ESSENTIAL SEWING SUPPLIES

- **Topstitching Needle** has a larger eye to fit two threads
- □ **All-purpose Thread** to match all fabrics (x2 for topstitching!)
- **Fabric Pencil** always need one of these on hand
- Craft Clips + Jumbo Craft Clips pins just aren't going to cut it
- **3/16" Double-sided Leather Tape -** to make your twill tape binding behave

#### **OPTIONAL** (but recommended!)

- **Edgestitch Presser Foot** for perfectly parallel stitches
- □ **Jean-a-ma-jig** for a lift over those bulky seams
- □ **Walking Foot** to give your sewing machine an extra boost
- **Rivet Removal Tool** because we all make mistakes!

## SLABTOWN TOOLS + SUPPLIES MAKE FROM SCRATCH

If you'd prefer to make your bag from scratch rather than from a kit, you'll need to purchase the pattern and then source the following materials:

## FABRIC

Mid-heavy canvas, waxed canvas, or denim

- □ **Main Fabric:** <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub> yard
- Accent Fabric: ½ yard
- Lining Fabric: <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard

## HARDWARE + NOTIONS

- (2) 12" Zippers with large hole in slider
- (24) Med. <sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"Tubular Rivets
- □ (2) Small ¼" Tubular Rivets
- (2) <u><sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Center Bar Buckles</u>
- □ (3) Line 24 Snaps
- **1" Twill Tape** (1 ½ yards)
- □ <sup>3</sup>⁄<sub>16</sub>" Double-sided Leather Tape

## LEATHER

- □ 40" x <u>1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Leather Strips</u> (8–10 oz)
- □ 100" x <u><sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Leather Strips</u> (8–10 oz)
- □ 6" x 3" **Leather Scrap** (8–10 oz)
- □ 5" x 2" **Leather Scrap** (5–7 oz) (See strap measurements in pattern)

## TOOLS + SUPPLIES

In addition to the essential tools and supplies listed on the previous page, you will need these tools to make your leather straps:

- **Round End Punches**  $\frac{3}{4}$ " + 1  $\frac{1}{8}$ " (or larger)
- Leather Pen

#### KIT CONTENTS

- Step-by-step instructions
- (2) Merino wool felt pads
- (4) Tubular rivets (+ 1 extra, just in case!)
- Leather glue + spreading tool

- Tubular Rivet Peening Tool
- Rotary Punch or <sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Drive Punch with cutting board
- Non-rubber Mallet
- Hard Setting Surface slab of stone, metal anvil, concrete floor
- Jumbo Craft Clips (optional)
- Leather Pen (optional)
- Paper towels or rag
