A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun.

A **subject pronoun** tells who is doing something. It is usually at the beginning of the sentence.

For example, "**She** painted."

An **object pronoun** comes after an action verb.

For example, "She painted **me**."

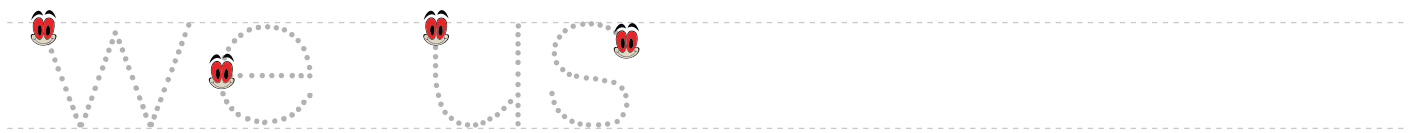
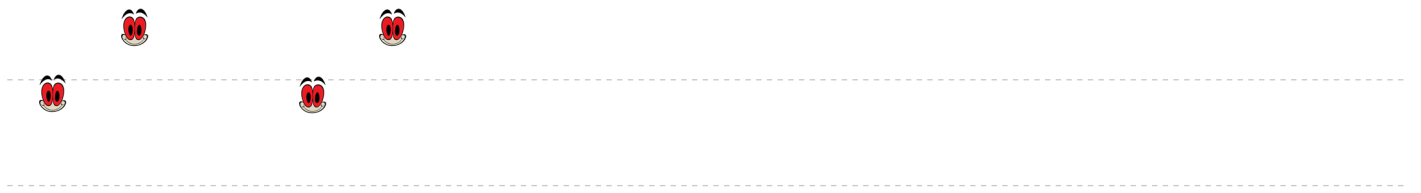
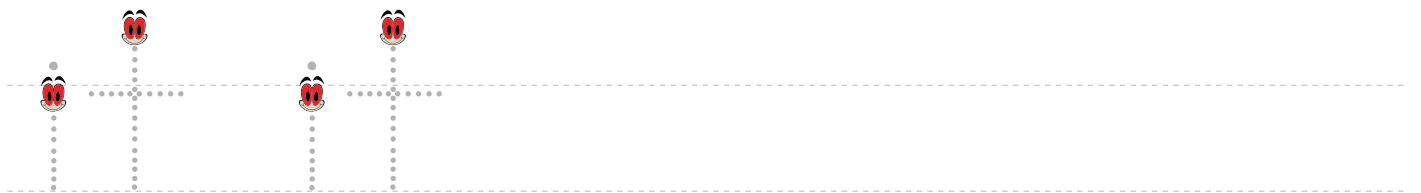
