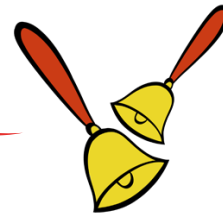
Some words look and sound the same but have different meanings. These are called homonyms. **Bark** is the noise that dogs make and the outside part of a tree.

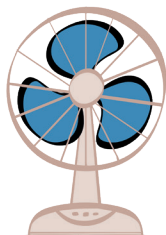

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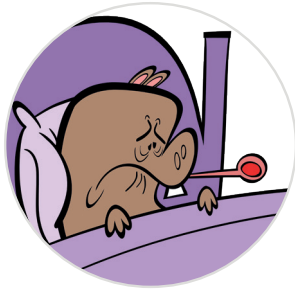
