Attaching the Little Sun Diamond to the Lantern







2. To turn on the

Alternative Light Source



1. Your Yemen Lantern can be lit with sustainable solar light from the Little Sun Diamond or alternatively with a candle that can be placed in the bottom of the lantern.

If using a candle, do not leave the lantern unattended, keep distance from flammable materials such as curtains (note that the candle will generate heat above the lantern lid) and avoid outdoor candle use in windy weather. 


