



warfair Donation Policy

February 2021

Purpose and objective

As a supplement to the income warfair generates through its business trading with quality products from conflict-affected countries, warfair accepts donations and financial contribution. Donations and financial contribution are greatly valued and contributes to the ability of warfair to invest in new products and markets.

To maintain its independence, protect its reputation and operate effectively warfair has established this donation policy to establish the key principles for receiving donations.

Policy

It is the policy of warfair to accept funding from any donor and whether monetary or in kind, provided that acceptance does not:

- impair the independence of warfair to pursue its mission.
- endanger its integrity and reputation.

Guideline

Care should be taken to ensure that donations or funding does not result in undue influence over the work of warfair. Subject to maintaining warfair's independence and reputation, warfair may accept funding from all kinds of sources.

If there is a significant risk that receiving funds from a particular source would impair warfair's independence or if there is a significant risk to warfair's reputation, then funding from that source will not be accepted by warfair.

warfair will list all donations and publicly disclose them in the Annual Report and on its website.

Application

When a new donation or financial contribution is offered to warfair, the Ethics Committee will be reviewing the offer and give its recommendations.

Revision

This policy will be revisited and revised as relevant every second year.
