

Each MDF sheet has an engraving which corresponds to the building.

CONSTRUCTION TIPS


Paint MDF before assembly - paint will not look good on the fadelight plastic. You can use a wash to add definition to fadelight.

PVA Glue is the best glue for MDF - assume glue is used except for fadelight, and where this symbol is shown



Any clouding on fadelight can be easily removed with a cloth or your fingernail.

Make sure to paint before assembly!








Glue the colums to the slab as shown























Glue the slab to the core





Pay attention to alignment so the fadelight plastic slots line up.





Slot the fadelight into the holes on the slab.

This part can be a bit tricky. Use rubber bands if it's curving too much.




Glue the roof slab to the central core.









Place these to secure the fadelight

You can use rubber bands to help keep the fadelight plastic from flexing too much









Glue the columns in place one by one, alternating to keep it even









This colum has a hook to secure the fadelight plastic gap







The hole next to the fadelight joint is where the hooked column should be placed









Use a rubber band while the glue is drying to keep it in place

Don't forget the roof condensors!

Glue the 4 walls to the ground slab as shown.












Slide the small fadelight pieces to the slots in the slab








Slide the long fadelight piece into the ground floor slab slots








Slide the 4 fadelight plastic parts into the slab with the hole










When you have all 4 fadelight plastic parts in place, fix the fadelight tabs to the roof slab slots.


It can be easier to use the hole so you hand can place the slots and tabs together.












You can now glue the roof to the inner walls






















(The next page shows the earlier steps) Before gluing the columns, Pay attention to make sure the columns with nubs at the top line up with the main roof slab.









Glue the pieces as shown and let dry - they will need to be dry to resist the placement of the fadelight plastic later. Everything shown should be painted before final assembly.




These pieces are the inside faces fadelight used for building D (The textured side is the external side)











3 colums have tabs at the top which correspond to the slots in the roof slab




















The textured, external side of the fadelight should be placed as shown so the door engraving matches the entrance.






























Carefully bend the fadelight into the hooks in the column as shown



Slot the fadelight plastic into the slots in the tabs. No glue required for the fadelight.














Pay attention to carefully line up the nubs with the slots of the roof slab

Make sure the roof ballustrade matches the height of the rear wall (Dry fit to make sure you have it the right way up, there's a slight difference)






































Do not glue these optional facades - they just sit in the slots and allow you to turn the museum/public building into a more secure fortress for sci-fi games.



















































I found it easiest to attach the Fadelight plastic to the top roof slab first, (1.) while upside down. Then insert the tabs into the lower ceiling tab. (2.)















Now you just have to glue the 3 sides and the roof of the plant room / A/C Condenser
